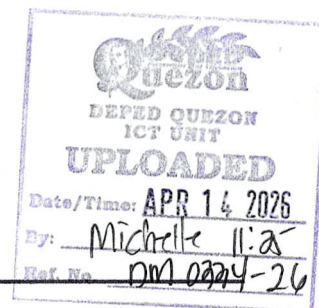

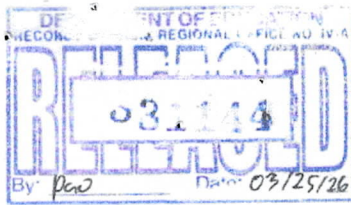

NEAP is a grant-in-aid program for the Philippine Department Committee (PDC) to support the study of highly qualified Filipinos in the US. It was structured to help the Philippines to attract and retain highly qualified Filipinos to be efficient and effective in the government service. Applicants are required to accomplish and submit the following documents: **Eligibility and Documentary Checklist (Enclosure 1)** and **Scholarship Clearance (Enclosure 2)**.

The following are the requirements for the NEAP Scholarship Program:

- a. Must be a Filipino citizen
  - b. Single
  - c. With a Bachelor's degree in any field
  - d. Philippine Resident
  - e. In excellent health
  - f. Not currently employed in government service
4. Nominated applicants are required to submit the following documents in PDF Form via the online application system, and observe the following deadlines. These requirements are as follows:
- a. Regional Office Nomination Form
  - b. Recent Personal Data Sheet (PDS)
  - c. Work Experience Sheet
  - d. Endorsements from the appropriate government agency/State/Division Office
  - e. Proofs of outstanding academic performance (e.g., Dean's List)
  - f. Two (2) most recent (last 2 years) performance ratings (e.g., Performance Appraisal (PCRF) ratings)
  - g. Updated Service Record
  - h. Certificate of No Pending Case
  - i. Passport
  - j. Work Application Plan
  - k. Medical Certificate
