3rd QUEZON PROVINCE LEARNERS' CONVERGENCE

1. In compliance with **DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2025** titled **Multi-Year Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities**, schools shall ensure that learners are exposed to varied experiences through programs such as the Learners' Convergence to further develop the learners' social, environmental, and leadership skills and talents. Hence, this Office, through the School Governance and Operations Division – Learner Formation Section (SGOD-LFS), shall conduct the **3rd Quezon Province Learners' Convergence (QP LearnCon)** on **May 14-16, 2026** at **Pagbilao National High School, Pagbilao, Quezon**.
2. The QP LearnCon shall be the largest face to face engagement of learners, youth leaders, and education stakeholders representing the various schools from the 39 municipalities of the province. This convergence shall provide learner-participants with the unique opportunity to not only gain insights from esteemed speakers and engaging activities but also to enrich their learning experience through interaction with one another, fostering a deeper understanding of diverse cultures across the province, and honing them to become effective leaders in their respective communities. Specifically, the QP LearnCon hopes to achieve the following objectives to have a genuine engagement with DepEd:
 - a. Cite DepEd key programs, projects, policies, and development opportunities for learners and educators;

- b. Share inputs, recommendations, and concrete initiatives to help solve challenges faced by the communities;
 - c. Participate in knowledge-sharing and problem-solving platforms on various issues that concern the youth and their communities;
 - d. Lead efforts in civic engagement, health and well-being, gender and social inclusion, climate action, innovation and future readiness, culture and arts, and peace; and
 - e. Network with a diverse community of advocates in delivering meaningful, responsive, and impactful change.
3. The upcoming convergence, with the theme, **#KabataangQuezonian: Kabataan ang Lakas ng Bayan, Aksyon ang Daan**, marks the third edition, in line with the conduct of the annual Learners' Convergence Philippines in the national level.
 4. Participation to this activity shall strictly comply with the existing DepEd guidelines concerning in-person activities as outlined in **DepEd Order No. 3, s. 2023** titled **An Order Allowing the Conduct of In-Person Activities in Schools**, and **DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2026** titled **Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education**.
 5. In line with the Department's commitment to prioritizing the best interest of learners in all decisions and actions involving them, and to protecting them against any form of abuse, violence, exploitation, discrimination, and bullying, full adherence to **DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012** titled **DepEd Child Protection Policy**, and **DepEd Order No. 31, s. 2022** titled **Child Rights Policy: Adopting the Rights-Based Education Framework in Philippine Basic Education** must be observed.

Administrative Guidelines

1. *Arrival of Participants*

- All participants shall arrive at the venue on Wednesday, May 13, 2026 (Day 0).
- Upon arrival, all participants must present their school identification card to the Technical Working Committee for attendance, verification, room assignments, and kit distribution.

2. *Billeting and Accommodation*

- All participants shall be billeted at the venue, Pagbilao National High School. Accommodation will run from 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 13, 2026, until 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 16, 2026. Participants shall bring their own beddings and sleeping materials.
- Any other expenses incurred while at the convergence venue, such as phone calls, personal meal orders, and the like, will not be covered by the organizers and must be charged to the participants' own account. Participants must also bring their own personal hygiene kits and personal medicines.

3. *Meals*

- The first meal to be served is breakfast on Thursday, May 14, 2026, while the last meal will be lunch on Saturday, May 16, 2026.

4. *Activities*

- The participants shall wear their best coachella attire for Day 1.
- The program of activities shall be followed as planned. In case of changes, the organizers shall duly inform the participants during plenary sessions to guide them throughout the program. Only announcements made by the QP LearnCon Technical Working Committee shall be recognized as official.
- The Technical Working Committee shall duly respond to the questions and concerns of the participants.

5. *Participation*

- All participants shall actively participate and fruitfully engage in all activities and sessions. Participants are highly encouraged to interact and collaborate with each other.
- The QP LearnCon Technical Working Committee, resource speakers, and activity facilitators shall guide the participants through the activities and sessions and shall respond to queries and concerns about the activities.

6. *Event Rules*

- The SGOD – Learner Formation Section is the head authority on all matters pertaining to the convergence.
- To ensure everyone’s health, safety, and well-being, all participants must adhere to the minimum public standards and protocols and to the learner rights and protection guidelines. Participants shall also be guided by the event’s contingency plan throughout the activity.
- All participants, organizers, partners, and service providers involved in the convergence shall adhere to the principles of social inclusion, recognizing diversity of backgrounds and identities. The SGOD – Learner Formation Section shall establish necessary arrangements, rules, and regulations to ensure safe spaces for all participants, especially the learners.

7. *Roles and Responsibilities*

- To ensure that participants are held accountable for their own actions during the event, learners are expected to carry out the following minimum assigned duties and responsibilities. To cite:
 - a. actively participate in QP LearnCon activities;
 - b. contribute to the creation of session outputs, provide relevant inputs, and constructive feedback as directed by the session facilitators and resource speakers;

- c. maintain the cleanliness and orderliness of the billeting areas and other event venues;
- d. practice decorum all throughout the event;
- e. communicate issues and concerns to the assigned chaperones or QP LearnCon Technical Working Committee in a polite and respectful manner;
- f. follow the prescribed dress codes and QP LearnCon ID during sessions;
- g. do not bring or possess prohibited articles, such as but not limited to deadly weapons, drugs, alcohol, toxic and noxious substances, cigarettes, and pornographic materials into the QP LearnCon premises (event venue or billeting areas); and
- h. perform other tasks assigned/requested by the QP LearnCon Technical Working Committee.

8. *Security and Valuables*

- All participants must take care of their own personal belongings and refrain from leaving their valuables unattended throughout the event. The QP LearnCon Technical Working Committee shall not be liable for any loss and damage of personal belongings while in the event.
- Should there be any untoward incidents during the event, the participants shall inform the QP LearnCon Technical Working Committee as soon as possible for immediate action.

9. *Wearing of Identification Card (ID)*

- QP LearnCon ID must always be worn for security reasons. No one shall be permitted to enter the QP LearnCon venue without ID.

10. *Health and Safety Protocols*

- All learners are presumed to be in good health. Those who are exhibiting any symptoms of illness shall inform the QP LearnCon Technical Working

Committee about their medical conditions and needs and shall be discouraged from attending the event activity.

- The QP LearnCon Technical Working Committee shall address the medical needs of the participants.

11. Learners' Rights and Protection

- The Department of Education (DepEd), the QP LearnCon Technical Working Committee, and through the Learner Rights and Protection Committee, ensures that all activities and venues are conducive and that the safety and well-being of the learners shall be the paramount consideration in all decisions and actions involving them. To provide special protection to learners who are gravely threatened or endangered by circumstances, the DepEd Child Protection Policy (DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012) shall be fully adopted before, during, and after the convergence. Yet, the participatory rights of the learners in the implementation of this policy and in all proceedings affecting them, whether they be victims or aggressors, either directly, or through a representative, is recognized.
- The QP LearnCon shall be in accordance with the safeguarding guidelines to minimize risk, guarantee safe space, and ensure positive experience for all participants, organizers, and others involved in the event. Further, through the safeguarding guidelines, appropriate preventive, protective, and remedial measures will be properly implemented.
- Accordingly, the DepEd and the QP LearnCon Technical Working Committee reiterates the zero-tolerance policy for any act of child abuse, exploitation, violence, discrimination, bullying, and other forms of abuse. Hence, a Child Protection Desk shall be fully operationalized through the Child Protection Committee (CPC) in the event venue and billeting areas.

12. Feedback and Evaluation

- To have a worthwhile QP LearnCon experience, participants should complete the feedback and evaluation form in exchange for the certificates.
