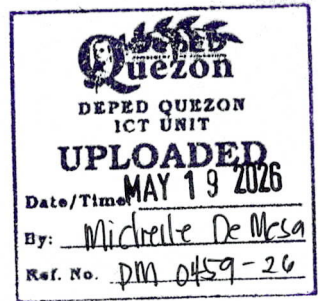

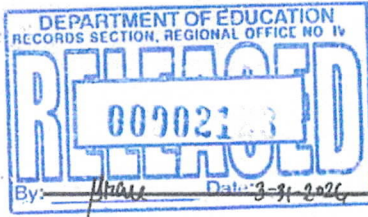
2. Listed schools shall submit means of verifications (MOVs) via email address of the Division Khan Academy Focal person at jaime.zarajr@deped.gov.ph. MOVs to be submitted shall include proof of compliance with the following requirements:
 - a. *Internet Connectivity – at least 100 Mbps*
 - b. *Device Availability – 1 device per student in the computer laboratory*
 - c. *Power Supply - stable*
 - d. *Computer Laboratory – secured and functional*
 - e. *School Readiness – SH and teachers are willing and committed*
3. Partnership with Khan Academy Philippines offers online platform which empowers learners to study at their own pace, both in and out of the classroom covering subjects from kindergarten through early college, including mathematics, science, reading and other areas.
4. Participation in this partnership program is **voluntary** and access to the online platform is provided free of charge.
5. Verified and certified schools will be given training for teachers prior and during the full implementation of the program.
