**CONDUCT OF THE STATE OF THE LEARNER GOVERNMENT ADDRESS (SOLGA)
FOR THE BEGINNING OF SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027**

1. In compliance with **OUOPS Memorandum No. 2023-03** titled **Interim Guidelines of the Learner Government Program (LGP)**, this Office, through the School Governance and Operations Division – Learner Formation Section (SGOD-LFS), informs all presidents of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) on the conduct of the State of the Learner Government Address (SOLGA) for the beginning of School Year 2026-2027.
2. As stated in Section 1.11, Article X of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government and Supreme Secondary Learner Government, the SELG/SSLG president shall conduct a State of the Learner Government Address (SOLGA) during the first and last quarter of the school year. All SELG/SSLG presidents shall conduct their SOLGA during the flag raising ceremony in their respective schools on **June 8, 2026**. The SOLGA must highlight significant plans and proposals on the following:
 - a. Promotion of DepEd's Core Values in the school
 - b. Programs, Projects, and Activities to be endorsed to the SGC
 - c. Learner support activities to assist learner-related outcomes
 - d. Resolutions/policy recommendations to be passed through the SELG/SSLG
 - e. Accomplishments of the SELG/SSLG during the conduct of Brigada Eskwela/Opening of Classes



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3. A one-page newsletter report with photo documentation shall be prepared and submitted by each elementary and secondary school to the District School Head In-Charge of Learner Formation in PDF file on or before **June 10, 2026**.
4. The District School Head In-Charge shall merge all submitted reports in one PDF file and upload the merged reports in the link **<https://tinyurl.com/SOLGABegin2627>** with the filename **District_SOLGA** on or before **June 11, 2026**.
5. Conduct of all activities related to the Learner Government Program (LGP) shall follow the provisions in **DepEd Order No. 09, s. 2005 – Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith; DepEd Order No. 03, s. 2023 – An Order Allowing the Conduct of In-person Activities in Schools; DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2026 titled Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education;** and community guidelines on safety and health protocols.
6. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
