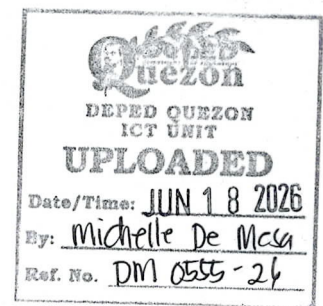

**PEDAGOGICAL RESKILLING ON THE ESSENTIALS OF STREAMLINING STORIES
(PRESS 2.0) FOR DIGITAL AND BROADCAST MEDIA**

1. Anchored on the provisions of Republic Act 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, along with the Republic Act 10533 or the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013 which strengthens journalism program, and in line with the implementation of Project KALILAYAN, and Curriculum Implementation's Project SHINE, this division announces the conduct of the Pedagogical Reskilling on the Essentials of Streamlining Stories for Digital and Broadcast Media on July 4-5, July 11-12, 2026 in a venue to be announced in a separate Memorandum.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. apply content knowledge in the conventions of journalism using varied journalistic strategies to improve learning outcomes and communities of practice;
 - b. display proficient knowledge and application of digital-based strategies and broadcast media conventions in the teaching-learning delivery of varied journalistic themes for engaging learning experiences;
 - c. utilize best practices in classroom communication strategies to support learner understanding, participation, engagement and achievement in varied journalistic environments and contexts;
 - d. prepare learners for digital and broadcast media activities.
3. Participants in this activity shall be the School Paper Advisers (SPAs) serving as coaches of digital and broadcast media: radio broadcasting, TV broadcasting, Collaborative Publishing, Online writing and publishing, and Mobile Journalism. Slots are also open to interested SPAs/ Journalism teachers who

want to learn the ropes of digital and broadcast media.

4. Only 130 slots shall be available on first come, first serve basis. Interested participants are advised to register through this link on or before June 26, 2026: <https://tinyurl.com/ProjectPRESS26>
5. Once registered, the participants shall be responsible to attend. In case of unavoidable conflict, the registered participant shall be responsible to send a replacement.
6. In as much as this activity is NEAP and PRC recognized, each participant is advised to double-check the accuracy of information they will provide in the online registration link.
7. Travel expenses of the participants may be charged against School MOOE, school paper fund, or any available local fund subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures.
8. Since this activity shall be held on weekends, the participants are entitled to service credits/Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) pursuant to DepEd Order No. 3, s. 2003, and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2 s. 2024 based on the actual service rendered.
9. Members of the Program Management Team (PMT) and Technical Working Group (TWG) are expected to attend the virtual meeting on June 26 (Friday) at 3:00 PM. Meeting link shall be posted in the group chat hours before the schedule.
