

POSTPONEMENT AND RESCHEDULING OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST FOR GRADE TWELVE IN AREAS AFFECTED BY ARMED CONFLICT

- With the recent armed conflict happening in the municipalities of San Andres and San Francisco, please be advised that the administration of the National Achievement Test for Grade Twelve (NAT-G12) will be temporarily suspended until the conflict has stopped and assessment activity is safe to conduct.
- Meanwhile, Public Schools District Supervisors and the Secondary School Heads of the affected areas are directed to refrain all activities and ensure that all learners and personnel are safe.
- Resumption of the NAT-G12 administration depends on the response of BEA to our request of rescheduling.
- 4. Widest and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

CANCELLATION/SUSPENSION OF NORMAL CLASSES IN ALL ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOLS OF BARANGAYS BUTANGUIAD, DON JUAN VERCELOS, CASAY, HUYON-UYON, INABUAN, MABUNGA, NASALAAN, PAGSANGAHAN, PUGON, SILONGIN AND STO. NINO, SAN FRANCISCO, QUEZON ON FEBRUARY 1-3, 2023

In view of the recent clashes between government security forces and armed rebels, and the still ongoing hot pursuit operations that has spilled over to some barangays of this municipality, the undersigned do hereby order the cancellation/suspension of classes at the elementary and high school levels in barangays BUTANGUIAD, DON JUAN VERCELOS, CASAY, HUYON-UYON, INABUAN, MABUNGA, NASALAAN, PAGSANGAHAN, PUGON, SILONGIN and STO. NINO on FEBRUARY 1-3, 2023 (Wednesday to Friday) so as to ensure the general welfare, public security and safety of the populace thereat, and to alleviate the psychological tensions that gripped our kababayan Aurorahins in the wake of these recent developments in our municipality.

Please take note that we have expanded the coverage of class suspension effective today January 31, 2023 to include all schools at the elementary and high school levels in brgy Inabuan, upon the request of its barangay officials after the dialogue between local government and barangay officials. Thus suspending classes in a total of eleven barangays in our municipality.

Subsequent decisions and actions relative to this internal security situation shall be made later in the week depending on the situation report by the government security and public safety forces (AFP and PNP).

DepEd officials are enjoined to coordinate with this office through the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (MDRRMO) and the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) for any necessary assistance needed.

Finally, we take this opportunity to call on our populace to stay calm and stay safe. Your Municipal Government is doing everything within its powers to assuage the impact of these recent events.

Please be guided accordingly. Mabuhay po kayo!
