In accordance with **DepEd Order No. 037, s. 2022** Guidelines on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the event of natural disasters, power outages/power interruptions, and Other Calamities and **PDRRC MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. DHT-006 s.2022** from the Office of the Governor of Quezon Province due to **SUPER TYPHOON "KARDING"** work in Division Office is hereby **suspended** on MONDAY, **SEPTEMBER 26, 2022**.
2. All SDO personnel are requested to stay at home and open the channel of communications in this time of need. This Office commits to the safety of all.
3. However, the personnel and unit directly involve in Division Disaster Risk and Reduction Management (DRRM) shall maintain their operations to monitor the situations of schools and ensure continuity of public service.

TO : ALL LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVES AND LOCAL DRRM OFFICERS OF COMPONENT CITIES & MUNICIPALITIES, PDRRMC MEMBERS, AND ALL OTHERS CONCERNED

SUBJECT : UPGRADING THE PDRRMC OPERATIONS ALERT STATUS TO RED ALERT EFFECTIVE TODAY, 24 SEPTEMBER 2022, AT 1800H

DATE : 1100H, 25 SEPTEMBER 2022

1. As of 11:00 am today, the center of **Super Typhoon "KARDING"** was estimated based on all available data at 175 km East of Infanta, Quezon, with a maximum sustained winds of 195 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 240 km/h, and central pressure of 920 hPa.

Super Typhoon "KARDING" is moving westward at 20 km/h with winds extending outwards up to 290 km. from the center.
2. In connection with the above-data and in accordance with DepEd Order No. 37, s. 2022, classes on **ALL LEVELS** are **AUTOMATICALLY SUSPENDED** on 26 September 2022 in the **WHOLE PROVINCE**, including the Cities of Lucena and Tayabas.
3. Work in government and private sector are likewise **SUSPENDED** on 26 September 2022 **except** those offices whose mandate pertains to delivery of health services, maintenance of peace and order, and disaster preparedness and response.
4. PDRRMC members and LDRRMCs are also directed to heighten the monitoring of their respective Areas of Responsibility and provide situational reports to this level thru the email address **pdrmo.quezon4a@gmail.com**.
