To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, CID and SGOD Chiefs, Public Schools District Supervisors, Elementary and Secondary School Heads, GAD Coordinators and All Others Concerned

- 1. Committed to integrate the principles of gender equality, gender equity, gender sensitivity, non-discrimination and human rights in the provision and governance of basic education, agencies are required to develop and maintain a Gender and Development (GAD) database containing gender statistics and sex-disaggregated data to serve as bases for gender analysis, planning, programming and policy formulation.
- The collection of gender statistics and sex-disaggregated data is primarily anchored on the Magna Carta of Women (RA 9710) which is also stipulated in the Gender-Responsive Basic Education Policy (DepEd Order No. 32, s. 2017) mandating all agencies to gather and analyze sex-disaggregated data and gender information for informed decision making.
