- 1. In line with the DepED Memorandum from the Office of the Undersecretary for Curriculum and Teaching regarding the 2024 Pambansang Buwan at Araw ng Pagbasa, the SDO Quezon wholeheartedly supports this initiative aimed at strengthening literacy programs for learners. With the theme "Sa PAGBASA may PAGASA," this office leads the national celebration in observance of Republic Act 10556, which designates November 27th as Araw ng Pagbasa. To kick off the event, the "Hatid Dunong sa Kabataan ng Quezon 2024" will take place from December 2-6, 2024, in the municipalities of Infanta, Sariaya West, Mulanay I, Alabat, and Perez, Quezon.
- 2. DepEd Quezon's "Hatid Dunong sa Kabataan ng Quezon" is a bookmobile project that started in 2009 to transport library hub materials to far-flung public schools to enhance reading and comprehension among learners within Quezon province. The main objective of this project is to give equal access to information, ideas, and knowledge through books, programs, and other resources by bringing supplementary reading materials to public schools in the whole province of Quezon. Specifically, it aims to:
 - a. provide adequate access to reading materials in the library hub;
 - b. promote the use of library hub books/materials;
 - c. increase the performance level in reading and comprehension among learners;
 - d. develop the genuine love and habit of reading, and enhance learner's reading comprehension skills.

- 3. The relaunching of Hatid Dunong comes with a twist. Instead of solely transporting books, it now incorporates storytelling sessions in English and Filipino done by selected storytellers in the district and engaging mind games/activities too, enhancing the educational experience and making learning more enjoyable for learners.
- 4. Every receiving district will receive a set of supplementary reading materials (SRMs) intended for learners to cultivate essential reading habits and skills. The distribution of these SRMs will be participated by the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, CID Chief, Education Program Supervisors, and Learning Resource Management of the Division.
