








IMPLEMENTATION OF ENHANCED LEARNING CONTINUITY PLANS (LCP) IN RESPONSE TO CLASS CANCELLATION

29 November 2024

AND WORK SUSPENSION Schools Division Superintendents

- Pursuant to Republic Act No. 9155, Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001 and in reference to DepEd Order No. 37, s. 2022, Guidelines on the Progressive Expansion of Face-to-Face Classes and other relevant issuances, this Office requires the field to update and enhance the school's Learning Continuity Plan (LCP) in response to class cancellation and work suspension.
- 2. The enhancement of the LCP is vital in ensuring uninterrupted learning amidst unforeseen class disruptions and cancellations (e.g., due to natural disasters, public health emergencies, or other circumstances) to attain the expected learning competencies/objectives within the school year. Hence, the LCP shall address the current challenges and unique context of schools within the region.
- 3. The Schools Division Offices (SDOs), through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) and the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) are expected to provide the necessary assistance to the school heads, teachers, and other schools and community learning center's stakeholders involved in the delivery of basic education programs. They are advised to conduct relevant activities, such as but not limited to the following:
 - a. risk analysis of possible disaster and emergency situations (historical data and frequency of occurrence of calamities) and the corresponding ADM to be implemented based on available resources;
 - b. consultation and recalibration workshops to enhance the LCP based on the context of the school/CLCs;
 - c. capacity-building activities for teachers and school heads on the implementation of the updated LCP especially the inclusion of the LCP in the SIP/AIP:
 - d. conduct of psychosocial intervention to affected learners and personnel, when deemed necessary;
 - e. periodic assessment of the effectiveness of the enhanced LCP.
- In the enhancement of the LCP, key components such as contextualization of learning modalities, inclusivity of the learning systems, standardization of mechanisms, instructional time adjustment, availability of resources, and integration/reconciliation of existing systems and policies must be







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considered. Specifically, in the implementation of the LCP, the learner who missed distance learning modality shall be accorded due consideration or flexibility in the accomplishment of their learning tasks by extending the time frame for their submission within the current quarter. Psychosocial activities must also be provided, if deemed necessary.

- 5. To extend technical assistance to the SDOs and schools, a monitoring activity will be conducted by this Office on a schedule that will be announced through a separate issuance. Enclosure 1 presents the Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Tool for the Implementation of the Enhanced LCP, which may be modified based on the context of the division and the schools. Monthly report on the modalities used by the schools must be collated and submitted by the SDOs to the RO through the PPRD.
- Activities relative to the enhancement and implementation of the LCP may be charged against division and school MOOE, local funds, and other sources available subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
