

THE ART OF STORY: EMPOWERING READERS WITH TEACHER-MADE VISUAL STORYBOOKS AND VIDEO NARRATIVES, A TRAINING-WORKSHOP

1. In line with the Department's thrust to enhance literacy and strengthen learning resource development at the school and division levels, the Curriculum Implementation Division – Learning Resource Management (CID-LRM) shall conduct a Training-Workshop on **"The Art of Story: Empowering Readers with Teacher-Made Visual Storybooks and Video Narratives"** on November 3-7, 2025 at M.I. Sevilla's Farm and Resort (Paul Hall Wing – Left Side), Brgy. Domoit, Lucena City.
2. At the end of the workshop, participants are expected to design and produce innovative, learner-centered multimodal literacy resources—such as storybooks, comics, digital illustrations, and storytelling videos—that will address reading remediation needs, motivate struggling readers, and promote creative, culturally responsive, and engaging learning experiences. Specifically, it aims to:
 - a. To equip participants with creative and technical skills in writing, illustrating, and producing engaging story-based materials that support reading remediation;
 - b. Introduce innovative approaches that combine visual, textual, and digital elements to make reading more accessible, enjoyable, and effective;
 - c. Provide hands-on experience in basic digital illustration and video editing tools to enable the production of interactive and multimedia learning resources;
 - d. Encourage teachers to create localized and contextualized materials that reflect learners' backgrounds, interests, and reading levels; and
 - e. Develop outputs that can be validated, published, and disseminated as part of the LRM team's support for literacy programs and inclusive education.

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3. Participants to this training-workshop are selected Learning Resource developers who will serve as writers, storytellers, digital illustrators, and video editors. They are advised to bring their own **laptop, digital tools, and extension cords** necessary for the development and completion of their outputs. Please see attached enclosure for the list of participants.
4. The resource persons are invited experts in story development, storytelling, digital illustration, and multimedia production, while the facilitators shall be the designated personnel from the Division Learning Resource Management Section.
5. This is a live-in training. Participants are expected to arrive at the venue by 1:00 p.m. on November 3, 2025 for the preliminary activities. They are advised to take their lunch before arrival, as the first meal to be served will be the afternoon snacks, and the last meal will be lunch on November 7, 2025.
6. All DepED Personnel who will render services on holidays shall be given service credit/compensatory time off.
7. Expenses relative to this activity such as foods, venue and accommodation shall be charged against Special Education Fund (SEF) while travel and other incidental expenses of participants and resource persons shall be charged against school MOOE, while expenses of the facilitators shall be charged to division MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. To ensure adherence to health and safety protocols in view of the prevalence of influenza-like illnesses, the conduct of this activity shall comply with PGO Quezon Executive Order No. DHT-60, s. 2023. Participants are advised to bring and wear face masks at all times, especially in indoor settings.
