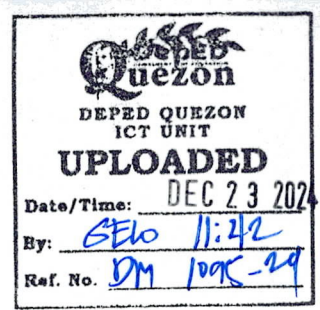

1. Relative to the **Regional Memorandum No. 867 s. 2024, Announcement of the Conduct of the 2025 Regional Festival of Talents (RFOT)** this Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division announces the conduct of **2025 Division Festival of Talents** to be held on **January 30, 2025** at Lutucan Integrated National High School, Sariaya West District, Sariaya, Quezon.
2. The 2025 Division FOT is aligned to SDO Quezon **KALILAYAN Agenda** (*L-Linangin ang kaalaman, kasanayan at pagpapahalaga ng mga mag-aaral at kawani sa iba't-ibang larangan ayon sa kasalukuyang kurikulum*), and Project **BLAZE** (**B**uilding **L**earners' **A**uthentic **Z**eal **o**f **E**xcellence).
3. The activity aims to provide opportunities for learners from public and private elementary and secondary schools as well as those from Alternative Learning System (ALS), Indigenous Peoples Education (IPED), Special Needs Education Program (SNEd), and Madrasah Education Program (MEP) to showcase their best products, services, and performance in different event categories. Specifically, it aims to:
 - a. provide a platform for diverse learners from public, private and alternative education systems to showcase their talents, skills, and innovative projects in various competitions.
 - b. cultivate innovative thinking to empower learners to develop critical thinking, problem-solving, and creative abilities through innovative projects and solutions;

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- c. improve oral communication skills to enhance learners' oral communication skills by providing opportunities to express ideas fluently and effectively in various speaking tasks;
 - d. promote camaraderie and learning to foster a positive and supportive learning environment that encourages healthy competition, collaboration, and the sharing of knowledge and experiences; and
 - e. apply knowledge and skills to provide learners with practical opportunities to apply their knowledge and skills in real-world contexts.
4. Participants in this activity are learners from the elementary and secondary schools, public and private, within the entire division with Learner Reference Number (LRN) for School Year 2024-2025, who are:

Participation in this activity is voluntary and shall not in any way, affect the time-on-task of teachers as this endeavor's target learning standards and competencies are already embedded in the teacher's actual classroom teaching and assessment processes.
8. All concerned participants shall be provided with learning interventions as part of their academic program to compensate for missed lessons through appropriate distance learning modality. Likewise, school heads concerned shall take responsibility for assigning competent teacher/s to handle the affected classes in compliance with teacher-pupils contact time.
9. The Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS) shall lead the conduct of the district elimination/selection of the participants for the congressional-level competition.
10. **The 1st and 2nd rank winners** in all categories of the congressional-level competition will compete at the division level. Each congressional level will send two (2) contestants per event for the 2025 DFOT.
