DIVISION ALGORITHM FOR COVID-19 PROTOCOLS AT SDO QUEZON

- To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, Division Chiefs, Education Program Supervisors, Public Schools District Supervisors, Elementary, Secondary, Senior High School Heads, Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel, School Health Personnel and All Others Concerned
 - Coronavirus or COVID-19 is a disease caused by Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome Coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2). It spreads primarily from person to person via droplets released when sick people with virus cough, sneeze or speak. It can also spread when in close contact with someone who's sick and through fomite.
 - The Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) Resolution No. 28
 mandates that minimum public health standards must be specified by the Department of Health
 (DOH) and adhered to by all sectors. These standards shall serve as a guide in institutionalizing
 key Non-pharmaceutical interventions (NPIs) to combat COVID-19.
 - Relative to the above mentioned resolution, DOH AO No. 0015 s. 2020 entitled "Guidelines on the Risk-Based Public Health Standards for COVID-19 Mitigation" was issued directing specific strategies to adhere and provide guidance on the implementation of a minimum standard in all sectors.
 - To effectively manage and assure the safety of SDO personnel attached hereto is the Algorithm for COVID-19 Protocols at SDO Quezon for strict compliance and implementation.
 - 5. All SDO personnel shall secure a Medical/Health Certification from their respective Barangay Health Emergency Response Team (BHERT) for renewal every 14 days to ensure that each individual are cleared and not classified as Suspect, Probable and Confirmed COVID-19 case in their respective municipality for submission to the School Health Section.
 - 6. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
