

lodged to Division Office as buffer stocks or will be distributed to other schools needing such. Unclaimed LRs shall be reported to this Office through LRM Section immediately by the Supply Officer for possible distribution to other schools.

- 4. Supplementary Learning Resource allocation per district can be accessed through https://tinyurl.com/QuezonLRdistribution. The recipient schools are selected based on the results of the Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy Program Assessment.
- 5. Schools shall maximize the utilization of SLRs in accordance with the objectives set in DepEd Order No. 24, s. 2023. Teachers are encouraged to incorporate these resources into their lessons to improve learning outcomes. Furthermore, all school stakeholders, including parents, must be informed about the proper care/handling and responsible use of these materials to preserve their quality and effectiveness, including appropriate storage and logbook of utilization.
- 6. The SDO shall regularly monitor the distribution and utilization of these SLRs. Schools are required to submit quarterly utilization report as per Regional Memorandum No. 59, s. 2025 re: Guidelines on the Proper Distribution and Use of Supplementary Learning Resources for Library Hubs Procured by the Regional Office.
