## SGOD-FTA GENERAL FINDINGS FOR CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT: QUARTER 1

- 1. With reference to Division Memorandum No. 69, s. 2021 (Technical Assistance Provision on School Operations) and Unnumbered Memorandum dated March 01, 2021 (TA Debriefing Session), this Office through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) informs all schools and district offices of the Team's general findings which may guide all concerned in the continuous effort to improve operations and governance practices.
- The DUYOG Uno led by SGOD Chief Elizabeth M. De Villa was able to provide TA to 20 schools in the districts of Padre Burgos, Catanauan 1 and 2, General Luna, and Pitogo; the DUYOG Dos, on the other hand, led by SEPS Paul Clifford N. Marquez was able to provide TA to 16 schools in the districts of San Antonio, Plaridel, and Sariaya East and West.
- 3. Common concerns had been discussed during the TA debriefing session; they are as follows:
  - a) Lacking/insufficient designation papers;
  - b) Absence of PAP Design/Proposal/Implementation Plan;
  - c) Lacking/poor M&E system for PAPs; and
  - d) Poor stakeholders' participation.
- To address the concerns above, the following actions are hereby expected to be taken:
  - a) That all Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs) and School Heads (SHs) are required to provide all program coordinators or focal persons with a designation paper

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including essential functions in the form of either a signed letter or school/district memorandum, thereby establishing accountability on performance;

- b) That all program coordinators or focal persons in the school/district are required to prepare and submit a PAP design or proposal to their respective PSDSs/SHs for approval, ensuring that said proposal is aligned with and included in the School Improvement Plan (SIP) and Annual Imperentation Plan (AIP);
- That the SGOD program coordinators are required to have their M&E tools quality
  assured and distributed to school/district coordinators, and whenever possible to create a
  unified M&E tool for SGOD; and
- d) That the SHs through the asssistance of their respective PSDSs are highly encouraged to strengthen their partnership programs and prepare appropriate documentation.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance to this Memorandum is desired.
