General Guidelines

A. Entry Requirements

- 1. Participants must be enrolled in the ALS LIS of the current year at the level that they will represent.
- 2. Each clustered district shall have four contestants: one in English and another in Filipino, for both elementary and secondary.
- 3. Registration form will be signed by the following: ALS Teacher/ CALSI, EPSA, and ALS Principal Consultant/PSDS.

B. Coverage of the Contest

1. The contest shall cover the fundamentals of paragraph writing in both English and Filipino.

- 2. A contestant shall be allowed to join in one category and one medium only.
- 3. Each contestant shall have 1 official coach who is an ALS Teacher/CALSI.
- 4. Failure to abide by the entry requirements would mean disqualification.

D. Mechanics of the Contest

The contest will be done online. A single theme will be given to the contestants per learning level: Elementary/JHS. They will be given one (1) hour to develop a handwritten paragraph.

During the submission, the contestant shall scan his/her entry and send through the link which would be given on the day of the contest.

The judges have direct access to the link for evaluation/scoring of entries.
