#### 2025 NATIONAL WOMEN'S MONTH CELEBRATION JUANA'S GOT TALENT MECHANICS

#### I. GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1) Overview: Juana's Got Talent is a singing competition aimed at celebrating National Women's Month through music, showcasing the talents of female employees and students in Quezon.
- 2) Competition Categories

Category 1: Elementary Category Category 2: High School Category Category 3: Employee Category

- 3. Elimination Stages
  - A. School Elimination The first level of the competition where contestants will compete at their respective schools. The winners of this round will advance to the District Elimination.
  - B. District Elimination Winners from different schools within a district will compete in this round. The champions from this stage will proceed to the Congressional Elimination.
  - C. Congressional District Elimination The winners from different districts will compete, and the champions in each category will qualify for the Grand Finals.
  - D. For SDO contestants, there will be a single elimination round. The winner will directly qualify for the Grand Finals. Elimination will be held on March 21, 2025, at the SDO Library Hub; 10:00 in the morning. For proper planning and management of the activity, interested participants are requested to register through the Division GFPS Secretariat, led by SEPS Regina V. Marino, not later than March 17, 2025.
  - E. Winners declared as the Most Talented Juana in each category during the Congressional Elimination will qualify for the Grand Finals on March 28, 2025, at Queen Margarette Hotel during the culminating activity of the National Women's Month.
  - F. To ensure that the competition aligns with the DepEd's policies on maximizing engaged time-on-task, all levels of the competition must adhere to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, which institutes measures to increase engaged time-on-task and minimize disruptions to class schedules.

#### **II. QUALIFICATIONS OF CONTESTANTS**

- a. Category 1. Elementary Category. Open to ALL FEMALE elementary students who are officially enrolled during the SY 2024-2025, provided she has not won in any regional, national, or international singing competitions.
- b. Category 2. High School Category. Open to ALL FEMALE high school students who are officially enrolled during the SY 2024-2025, provided she has not won in any regional, national, or international singing competitions.
- c. Category 3. Employee Category. Open to ALL FEMALE employees of DepEd Quezon, regardless of the status of appointment including teaching personnel, provided they have not won in any regional, national, or international singing competitions. Teaching personnel who will join must observe maximizing time-on-task engagement and must assure that home-based learning activities are provided in the affected classes.

### **III. CONTEST GUIDELINES**

- Contestants shall perform one (1) OPM song that promotes women empowerment and with relevance to the National Women's Month.
- Contestants shall perform live and may use a minus-one track or live accompaniment.
- Attire must be decent, appropriate, and may incorporate the color purple, symbolizing gender equality and women's empowerment.
- Each contestant will be given a maximum of 5 minutes for their performance.

#### **IV. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING**

- Vocal Performance (50%)
- Evaluation of pitch, breath control, tone, enunciation, phrasing, dynamics, voice range, and singing intervals.
- Expression/Showmanship (30%)
- Assessment of how well the singer conveys the song's message and connects with the audience through eye contact, body language, and facial expressions.
