

In partnership with Ateneo de Manila University, SBFI have developed short English Reading student assessments that teachers training participants can voluntarily administer to their students. In return, SBFI will be giving monetary incentives to teachers who will have the:

- · Most number of learners administered with the exam; and
- Highest average score of all learners administered with the exam provided average score is at least 80%.
