The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the Lamisahan National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged against the current year's appropriation of the Manicahan National High School - Lamisahan Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 4. Within sixty (60) days after the approval of this Act, the Secretary of Education shall promulgate the rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act.

SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
