

Education plays a vital role in forwarding initiatives in ecosystem restoration. Instilling appreciation and awareness of the rich biodiversity of the Philippines is a way to deter destructive human activities. In this regard, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) and the Biodiversity Conservation Society of the Philippines (BCSP), developed the **Philippine Biodiversity Toolkit for Teachers**.
