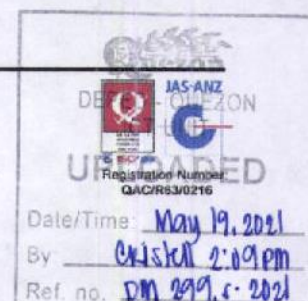
1. Physical Education and Health as components of MAPEH are branches of learning which involve the application of theories and skills that will help the learners attain balance in the way life is lived. MAPEH Curriculum equip our teachers with the knowledge they can use to transfer among learners the knowledge and skills they need. For this purpose, A Seminar – Workshop on Utilizing Methods and Strategies in Teaching Physical Education and Health for Elementary and Secondary MAPEH Teachers will be held on May 24-26, 2021 at Sevilla's Resort and Hotels. The said training is under Project SHINE Strengthening Holistic instructions to Nurture Teaching Empowerment of the Curriculum and Instruction Division.
2. The training aims to develop pool of elementary and secondary teachers on the utilization of methodologies and strategies in teaching Physical Education and Health.
3. Each District shall send one MAPEH teacher who specializes in dance and sports and must be physically fit to do strenuous calisthenics.
4. Participants are requested to bring the following: folder, envelope, sports attire and badminton equipment.
5. Each participant is expected to report to the venue at 4:00 PM on May 24, 2021 (Day 0). The opening program will be at 5:30 PM and the first meal will be served after the program while the last meal will be a snack on the afternoon of May 12.
