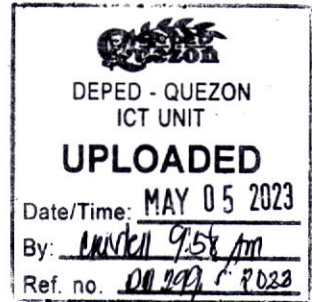

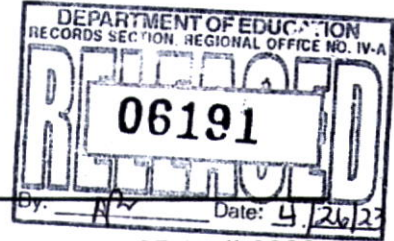

**IMPLEMENTATION OF BLENDED LEARNING DELIVERY  
 MODALITY (BLM) IN SCHOOLS AFFECTED  
 BY EXTREME CLIMATE CONDITIONS**

To: **Schools Division Superintendents  
 Functional Division Chiefs  
 School Heads**

1. In compliance with DepEd Order No. 37, s. 2022 titled: Guidelines on the cancellation or suspension of classes and work in schools in the event of Natural Disasters and other calamities such as extreme heat, this Office will implement the shifting of in-person classes to blended learning modality to avoid congestion in the classrooms, while looking after the health, safety and well-being of its learners, teachers and personnel and ensure that learning competencies and objectives are still met and teaching learning continuity is strictly observed.
2. The School Heads are advised to implement the Blended Learning Modality (BLM) with flexibility based on the school context and prepare a school contingency plan. Please refer to the attached checklist for consideration in the implementation of BLM.
3. The suggested checklist will be used by the SDO monitors and Regional Office monitors/validators to evaluate/validate the progress of the implementation of the BLM and be used as the basis in the provision of Technical Assistance (TA). The SDOs are advised to establish/create the SDO monitoring team to ensure the full implementation of the blended learning delivery modality in schools affected by extreme heat and shall submit consolidated report to RO **2 weeks** after the start of its implementation. The RO monitoring team shall in turn validate the submitted reports by the SDO monitoring team.
4. Please refer to the list of competencies for the quarter four (Q4) intended for Key Stage 1 (KS-1) to KS-4 learners to complete the implementation of the curriculum for School Year (SY) 2022-2023 and the list of names of Regional Monitoring /Validating Team (RMT/RVT).
