SAFEGUARDING AND PROPERLY STORING SUPPLEMENTARY LEARNING MATERIALS DURING NATIONAL AND LOCAL ELECTIONS AND SCHOOL VACATION

- 1. This Office reiterates the guidance provided in Regional Memorandum No. 203, s. 2025, regarding precautionary measures to ensure the safety and proper storage of Supplementary Learning Resources (SLRs) during national and local elections, as well as school vacation periods. These measures include, but are not limited to, conducting inventories, storing materials in secure areas, limiting access, implementing preventive protocols especially during elections, and carrying out thorough inspections.
- 2. In the event of any missing or damaged learning resources during the aforementioned periods, concerned parties are requested to promptly report the incident to this Office through the Supply Section for appropriate action copy furnished the Curriculum and Instruction Division Learning Resource Management Section (CID-LRMS).

ENSURING THE SAFETY AND PROPER STORAGE OF SUPPLEMENTARY LEARNING RESOURCES DURING THE NATIONAL AND LOCAL ELECTIONS AND LONG VACATION PERIOD

To Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. To ensure the protection and preservation of supplementary learning resources during elections and long vacation periods, all Schools Division Offices and Schools are directed to implement the following safety measures:
 - a. Conduct an Inventory
 - List all supplementary learning resources, including books, printed materials, digital files, and manipulatives.
 - Record and update the school property log to track available materials.
 - b. Securely Store Resources
 - Keep learning resources in a locked storage area, such as the school library or a designated secure room.
 - Use waterproof and fireproof containers for important documents and materials.
 - c. Restrict Access
 - Assign responsible personnel or team to oversee the security of stored resources.
 - · Limit access to authorized staff to prevent loss or damage.
 - d. Implement Precautionary Measures During Elections
 - If the school is used as a polling station, move valuable materials to a secure location.
 - Coordinate with election officers to ensure that learning resources are not accessed or displaced.
 - e. Inspect Before and After the Elections/Long Vacation Period
 - Conduct a thorough inspection of storage areas before and after the election or vacation.
 - Report any missing or damaged resources to the Schools Division Office.
