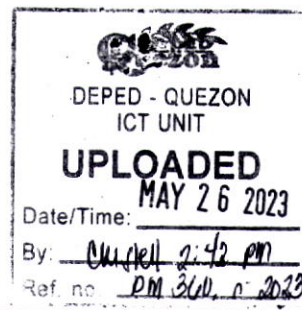

1. Relative to the Annual Division Early Grade Math Assessment for Grade One set on June 15-16, 2023 as per calendar of activities for SY 2022 - 2023, the assessment may be conducted earlier starting May 22 to June 2, 2023.
2. The Early Grade Math Assessment (EGMA) for Grade One is under Project **T-MATH**: Teacher-Materials/Activities for Active Teaching-Learning Habit, that supports Project **BLAZE**: Bridging Learners Authentic Zeal of Excellence and Project **GLOW**: Getting Learning Outcomes Worthwhile.
3. EGMA is an instrument used to assess Grade One pupils performance on the most fundamental and predictive competencies needed for future success in mathematics.

To wit:

- a. oral counting
- b. rational counting
- c. number identification
- d. number discrimination
- e. missing number
- f. addition
- g. subtraction
- h. word problems

4. All schools are advised to conduct the activity by selecting Grade one pupils through random sampling procedures discussed during the virtual meeting of D-SHICOM on May 5, 2023.
 5. Every district has soft copy of the EGMA Tool. Materials for the reproduction of the EGMA Tools and answer sheets shall be charged to School MOOE/Local funds subject to the usual auditing and accounting procedures. The printing of the assessment tool is not per pupil. It is according to the number of Key teachers to be assigned to administer the assessment. Only the answer sheet shall be printed for each pupil who shall take the assessment.
 6. The District School Heads in-charge of Mathematics (D-SHICOM) in coordination with PSDS and other School Heads shall oversee the activity in collaboration with the school Math Coordinators and Grade One teachers. The working committee shall be formed within the district and shall sign an Oath of Confidentiality to keep the integrity of assessment results and its purpose.
 7. The working committee shall strategize on the smooth flow of the activity and shall be provided with certificate of appreciation to be signed by the Public Schools District Supervisor.
 8. The conduct of activity shall adhere to the no-disruption of classes and to ensure the implementation of health and safety protocol, teachers and pupils shall wear face mask because it is a teacher- pupil one-on-one oral assessment.
 9. The EGMA results shall be thoroughly checked by all concerned and submitted to this link <https://tinyurl.com/NumMathMPS> Sheet 3 on or before June 5, 2023.
 10. Full cooperation of all concerned is highly expected.
