

- 1. In line with **DepEd Memorandum No. 017, s. 2024** (Updates on the Implementation of the Joint Delivery Voucher Program (JDVP) for Senior High School Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (SHS-TVL) Specializations for School Year (SY) 2023-2024), this Office will conduct a monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of the JDVP for SHS-TVL Specializations for SY 2023-2024 from **April to May 2024**.

- 4. All Public Schools District Supervisors shall conduct monitoring and evaluation of the JDVP following the attached **prescribed tool (Annex 11)**.

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




















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

- 6. All concerns needing immediate attention shall be reported directly to the DMET, in coordination with the Division JDVP Focal Person, for appropriate actions.
- 7. All related expenses to be incurred by the DMET and PSDSs in the conduct of the monitoring and evaluation activity shall be charged against the Division MOOE, while that of school heads shall be charged to their respective school MOOE, subject to existing COA rules and regulations.







