1. Based on the feedback of School Based Management (SBM) implementers in the field regarding the difficulties encountered in documenting, computing, and validating school practices on the four (4) principles of SBM, this Office through the School Governance and Operations Division issues a survey to gather data and note relevant needs in respect to **Republic Act No. 9155** (Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001) that devolves management based on actual needs of the school community, as well as the guidelines stipulated in **DepEd Order No. 83, s. 2012** (Implementing Guidelines on the Revised School-Based Management, Assessment Process and Tools) which provides for the SBM framework and assessment of practices for improvement and/or accreditation.
2. This survey intends to resolve persistent issues encountered by schools, thereby recommending appropriate policy actions to further improve SBM implementation in the entire Division. Its parts cover SBM documentation, self-assessment, computation, measuring quality, processing D-O-D, verifying MOVs, and assessing validators' competence.
