In response to the Audit Office Memorandum (AOM) recommendations issued by the office of the resident auditor of SDO Quezon, this office initiates measure to gather up to date data on School Buildings and Other School Properties for the purpose of budgetary allocations for the insurance requirements under General Insurance Fund (GIF) of the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS) as a mandatory requirement under item 1.0 of COA Circular No. 92-390 and section 11 of the Republic Act (RA) No. 656 known as the Property Insurance Law.
- 2. All school heads with the help of school and district property custodians are advised to accomplish the template on Consolidated Report on Physical Count of School Buildings accurately through submission of hard copies to respective District Property Custodian for consolidation on or before June 18, 2021. The consolidated inventory by districts shall be submitted to this Office on or before June 25, 2021 through the email of Supply Section at sdo.quezon.supply@deped.gov.ph.
