**PREVIEW OF THE REVITALIZED DIVISION MONITORING AND EVALUATION PLAN
ADJUSTMENTS (DMEPA 2.0) IN THE NEW NORMAL**

To: OIC-Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, CID and SGOD Chiefs, Section/Unit Heads, Public Schools District Supervisors, Elementary and Secondary School Heads and Teachers, and Others Concerned

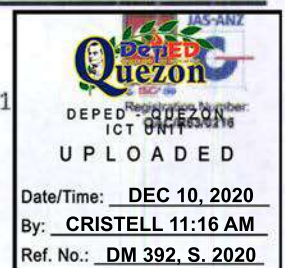
1. In response to the New Normal in basic education, the need for adjustment in the implementation of school programs and projects has to be included in the Department of Education's (DepEd) efforts towards developing the Learning Continuity Plan (LCP) that is most appropriate to current situations of schools today and beyond. To this effect, the Schools Division Office (SDO) of Quezon province shall make necessary adjustments too on the schedule and modality of regular conduct of the **Revitalized Division Monitoring and Evaluation Plan Adjustments in the New Normal**, which shall be hereby termed as **DMEPA 2.0**.
2. It shall be noted that as a system, **monitoring and evaluation (M&E)** is ingrained in the implementation of programs, activities and projects (PAPs) in the school, district and division offices. Hence, M&E should be done regularly depending on the office or school's M&E plan. Quarterly review of office or school performance should be followed consistently, led by the office/section/school head. Evidence of M&E should also be kept as Means of Verification (MOV) for external validation.
3. In preparation for the scheduled **reorientation on DMEPA** in 2021, all schools are advised to prepare their **SMEPA/DisMEPA data**. The said data may include **enrolment** for SY 2020-2021 (compared to BoSY enrolment in SY 2019-2020); number/percentage of **dropouts** for SY 2019-

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- 2020; **MPS** in all learning areas for SY 2020-2021 (first quarter only); and a list of **challenges encountered** and **lessons learned** in the operationalization of the school LCP.
4. A **brief report** (on slides/PPT presentation; maximum of 20 slides; using graphical/tabular presentations or info-graphics) shall be submitted by the district office until **January 11, 2021** through tinyurl.com/DMEPA20preview.
 5. The **Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs)** are **empowered to identify and add** other important data in their report regarding the programs implemented by the SDO. Please be reminded that the said report will be used only to gather insights on how to better improve the new guidelines and templates for the DMEPA 2.0 come 2021.
 6. The revised DMEPA guidelines and final schedule of reorientation shall be issued on a separate Memorandum, including new mechanics of implementation and templates.
 7. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
