

Annex A

List of Requirements for SPFL Chinese Mandarin

- 1. Indorsement from the Schools Division Office and Regional Office
- 2. School Initiated Survey
 - a. This should include the School Profile
 - b. Number of prospective SPFL Chinese Mandarin learners
 - c. Perceived benefits of SPFL Chinese Mandarin to the learners
- 3. Community Map
 - a. This should show the existence of a Chinese Mandarin -related environment (Grocery Store, Factory, Restaurant, and other establishments where learners will be able to practice the language)
- 4. Proof of Compliance
 - a. Classroom Size the school must have adequate instructional rooms that conform to the minimum standard for instructional spaces as stipulated in the Manual of Educational Facilities. It should be able to accommodate a maximum of 35 students per class. Initially, SPFL Chinese Mandarin classes will need a classroom for two classes that may take turns or two separate classrooms if SPFL Chinese Mandarin classes will be simultaneous.
 - Availability of Resources and Learning Materials related to the language offered.
- 5. Teacher Nominees
 - a. Personal Data Sheet of Two (2) New Teacher Nominees who will undergo series of trainings in teaching the Chinese Mandarin Language
 - b. The following are the criteria set in choosing the teacher nominees:
 - Commitment to complete the language training, immersion program and SPFL classroom teaching for at least 3 years.
 - Physically and mentally fit to complete the training and immersion (with a medical certificate from a government hospital).
 - Sense of responsibility, accountability, regard, and passion to learn the language in order to equip our learners with communication skills.
