Title of the Research (1 Slide)	Title of the Study, Researcher/s, Workstation	
Introduction/Rationale/ Background of the Study (1 slide)	Discuss the problem or issue that inspires the researcher/s to conduct the study	
Statement of the Problem (1-2 slide/s)	Present the statement of the problem	
Theoretical/Conceptual Framework (1 slide)	Present the theoretical or conceptual framework used in the study	
Methodology or Scope of the study	Present the research design, methodology, respondents, research local and ethical considerations	
Research Findings (1-7 slides)	Present the findings in each specific question / objective. Use graphic organizer / picture to support your findings.	
Conclusion and Recommendations (1-3	Short conclusion synthesizing the findings.	
slides)	Specify recommendations based on the	
	findings.	
References (1 slide)	In bullet form, present the relevant references used in the study.
