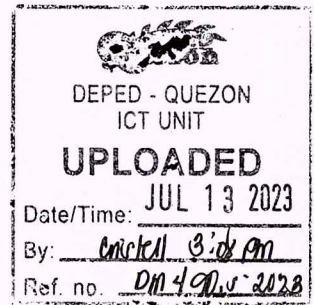

Declamation Contest (Elementary Students)	
1.	The contest is open to all Elementary (grades 1 – 6) students of both private and public schools in the Division of Quezon, Lucena City and Tayabas City.
2.	The LGUs, thru the Municipal Tourism Offices, shall conduct Congressional District Elimination Round for Declamation contest.
3.	The venue for the Congressional Elimination round will be as follows; 1 st District – Real, Quezon, 2 nd District – Sariaya, Quezon, 3 rd District – Catanauan, Quezon, and 4 th District – Gumaca, Quezon.
4.	Each Local Government Unit will be represented by one contestant for declamation to compete during the congressional district elimination round.
5.	The Champion of each of the four Congressional District will compete in the Final Round on August 16, 2023, 4 PM, main stage of the festival grounds during the Niyogyugan Festival 2023.
6.	Prizes, including consolation for non-winners during the Congressional District Competition and Final Round will be provided by the Provincial Government.
7.	Congressional District Champions, thru the LGU/MTO they represent will submit a copy of their declamation piece to the Provincial Tourism Office on or before August 8, 2023.
8.	The declamation piece, in Filipino or Tagalog language, can be made or authored by the teacher/ students that focuses on the given theme “THE LIFE OF PRESIDENT MANUEL LUIS QUEZON”.
9.	The declamation should be memorized and should be delivered in 5 – 7 minutes. Notes and cue cards are not allowed during the contest.
10.	The sequence of presentation shall be determined by their congressional district.
11.	The contestants will be required to wear their school uniform.
12.	In the championship round, live presentation will be done at the Perez park during the Niyogyugan Festival 2023.
13.	During the live presentation, the contestant must ensure that the speaking area on which the contestant stands must be visible along with his/her entire body movements/gestures.
14.	Timing begins on the first word and stops on the last word uttered. One point deduction from the over-all-score shall be imposed for every 30 seconds exceeding time.
15.	The timer will be placed in a position that will be very visible to the screen of the finalists. Finalists will see a show board sign the moment that they utter the first word, when they have two minutes left, and when the time limit has elapsed.
16.	The use of props, prompters, special costumes, and visual and audio-visual aids are not permitted. Singing and dancing, are also prohibited.

Oration Contest (Junior/Senior High School and College Level)	
1.	The contest is open to all Junior/Senior High School (grades 7 – 12) and College students of both private and public schools in the Division of Quezon, Lucena City and Tayabas City. (High School vs. High School and College vs. College)
2.	The LGUs, thru the Municipal Tourism Offices, shall conduct Congressional District Elimination Round for Oratorical contest.
3.	The venue for the Congressional Elimination round will be as Follows: 1 st District – Real, Quezon, 2 nd District – Sariaya, Quezon, 3 rd District – Catanauan, Quezon, and 4 th District – Gumaca, Quezon.
3.	Each Local Government Unit will be represented by one contestant from Junior/Senior High, and one contestant from college level for oration to compete during the congressional district elimination round.
4.	The Champion of each of the four Congressional District will compete in the Final Round on August 16, 2023, 4 PM, main stage of the festival grounds during the Niyogyugan Festival 2023.
5.	Prizes, including consolation for non-winners during the Congressional District Competition and Final Round will be provided by the Provincial Government.
6.	Congressional District Champions, thru the LGU/MTO they represent will submit a copy of their oratorical piece to the Provincial Tourism Office on or before August 8, 2023.
7.	The declamation piece, in Filipino or Tagalog language, can be made or authored by the teacher/ students that focuses on the given theme “THE LIFE OF PRESIDENT MANUEL LUIS QUEZON”.
8.	The oration should be memorized and should be delivered in 5 minutes. Notes and cue cards are not allowed during the contest.
9.	The sequence of presentation shall be determined by their congressional district.
10.	The contestants will be required to wear their school uniform.
11.	In the championship round, live presentation will be done at the Festival Stage during the Niyogyugan Festival 2023.
12.	During the live presentation, the contestant must ensure that the speaking area on which the contestant stands must be visible along with his/her entire body movements/gestures.
13.	Timing begins on the first word and stops on the last word uttered. One point deduction from the over-all-score shall be imposed for every 30 seconds exceeding time.
14.	The timer will be placed in a position that will be very visible to the screen of the finalists. Finalists will see a show board sign the moment that they utter the first word, when they have two minutes left, and when the time limit has elapsed.

CONTEST MECHANICS

General Mechanics

The Quiz Bee is individual in nature. Each local government unit through its Municipal Tourism Office shall be represented by one (1) contestant per category.

Categories are ELEMENTARY, JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL and SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL. Each category shall have three (3) rounds namely: Easy, Average, and Difficult. In case of tie, Clincher questions shall follow.

Questions shall focus on Manuel L. Quezon and his legacy. In celebration of the National Language Month (Buwan ng Wika), questions shall be in Filipino. The Department of Education through its three (3) Divisions (Quezon, Tayabas and Lucena) shall be responsible for the formulation of pool of questions (per category, per round).

This is a traditional face to face quiz bee and shall be conducted simultaneously. The contestants shall write their answers on their own provided card boards.

The results of the contest as proclaimed by the Board of Judges shall be final, non-appealable and irrevocable.

Note that the result of this contest shall have a bearing on the over-all standing of LGUs in the Niyogyugan Festival 2023.

Participants

One contestant per category.

Elementary category shall be represented by an incoming Grade 6 student for CY 2023-2024.

Junior High School Category shall be represented by an incoming Grade 10 student for CY 2023-2024.

Senior High School Category shall be represented by an incoming Grade 11 or 12 student for CY 2023-2024.

Each contestant shall have his/her corresponding coach.

Each contestant shall provide his/her own card board (1/8 size), chalk and eraser.

Mobile phones or gadgets are prohibited during the competition.

Wearing of contestant's school uniform is required.

An endorsement or certification from the Local Government Unit (LGU) that the bearer is the official representative for MLQ Quiz Bee 2023 (Tagisan ng Talino) and that he/she is a qualified contestant for the category is required upon registration.

Only the contestant can proceed to the designated Quiz Bee area. A holding room shall be provided for Coaches.

Board of Judges

The Board of Judges shall be composed of a representative (Education Program Supervisor) from Department of Education Divisions of Quezon, Tayabas and Lucena.

Technical Working Group (TWG)

Each category shall be facilitated by a Quiz Bee Master, timer, checker, scorer from the different Dep Ed Divisions.

Quiz Bee Master for each category includes the following:

- Elementary - Dep Ed Division of Lucena
- Junior High School - Dep Ed Division of Quezon
- Senior High School - Dep Ed Division of Tayabas

TWG members from the three (3) Dep Ed Divisions shall elect among themselves the composition of TWGs (timer, checker, scorer) in each category making sure that each Dep Ed Division is represented in every category for transparency purposes.

Employees from the Quezon Provincial Library and Provincial Tourism Office shall facilitate other TWG activities such as secretariat, usher/usherette, ways and means.

Registration and Seating Arrangement

Online registration is required. Each contestant shall register online through a link provided <https://forms.gle/yxuwiHncNQwzEH5j8> on or before August 4, 2023. Endorsement or certification as official Quiz Bee representative shall be attached on the google form provided.

During the contest proper, each contestant together with his/her coach shall register/confirm registration on their respective category.

Numbering/seating arrangement shall be based on the time of their arrival (first come, first registered basis).

Each coach shall be assisted to the designated holding room/area.

Contest Proper

The contest shall start as scheduled.

The Quiz Bee master shall read/orient the contestants on the guidelines and procedures of the contest.

Answering Mechanics

The Quiz master shall draw questions from the question box. Five (5) questions shall be asked per round.

Questions shall be read twice. The ten (10) second time limit shall automatically start with the "go" signal of the Quiz Master.

When the time is up, contestants shall be asked to raise their card boards for checking and computation.

Any question or query to the correctness of the answer should be raised before the start of the next question.

Scoring Mechanics

The contest shall follow a point system of scoring:

Easy Round	- 1 point
Average Round	- 2 points
Difficult Round	- 3 points

Easy and average rounds are multiple choice questions.

Difficult and clincher questions shall be identification type.

At the end of each round, the cumulative score of each participant shall be computed and announced by the Quiz Master.

At the end of the contest, the contestant with the highest cumulative score shall be declared 1st place winner. The next two (2) highest scoring contestants shall be declared as 2nd and 3rd place winners.

Tie Breaking Mechanics

In case of tie, clincher questions shall be asked.
The winner shall be determined on a first to score basis.

Protest Mechanics

The contestant is the ONLY authorized person to make a protest.
Protests should be referred to the Board of Judges immediately, before the Quiz Master reads the next question.

In case of ambiguous or debatable questions, the Quiz Master and/or the Board of Judges shall have option to draw another question.

The Board of Judges will be in complete control. Their decision shall be final in all questions/protests.

Prizes (Per Category)

- 1st Place - Php 15,000.00, trophy and certificate of recognition
- 2nd Place - Php 10,000.00, trophy and certificate of recognition
- 3rd Place - Php 7,000.00, trophy and certificate of recognition
- 10 consolation prizes of Php 3,000.00 and certificates of recognition

In case of tie in consolation prizes, cash prizes shall be divided equally.

Certificates of participation shall be given to every contestant and their registered coach.

Awarding ceremonies shall immediately follow after the contest.
