

- 1. To promote a strong culture of research and disseminate research findings in reference with DepEd Order No. 16, s. 2017 (Research Management Guidelines), this Office, through the Schools Division Research Committee (SDRC), announces the Call for the 2024 Division Conference of Basic Education Researchers (DCBER), the venue and date to be announced later.
- 2. The 2023 DCBER specifically aims to:
 - a. Disseminate research results as basis for policy formulation or improving instructional practices;
 - b. Share best practices and innovations for possible utilization/adoption; and
 - c. Network with other education researchers to discuss challenges and trends or exchange resources for the conduct of research.
- 3. The Call is open to all educational leaders and managers, school heads, teachers, and non-teaching personnel in the Division.
- 4. The Eighth/Ninth Cycle BERF grantees are expected to present their research outputs in the conference through poster display as part of research dissemination.

Guidelines for the Submission of Research Abstracts

- 1. The target participants are educational leaders and managers, school heads, teachers, and non-teaching personnel in the Division.
- 2. The researchers should ensure alignment of their completed research on the priority research themes (and cross-cutting themes, if applicable), indicated in the Basic Education Research Agenda (BERA), such as:

Main Themes:

- a. Teaching and Learning
- b. Child Protection
- c. Human Resource Development
- d. Governance

Cross-cutting Themes:

- a. Disaster Risk Reduction and Management
- b. Inclusive Education
- c. Gender and Development
- 3. Research studies must have been completed from 2023 to 2024.
- 4. The findings generated fom the identified research themes should yield towards evidencebased actions for ensuring access to basic education, improving the quality of education, and ensuring effective, transparent, engaging and accountable governance, along the DepEd-MATATAG Agenda and the Division KALILAYAN.
- 5. Abstract should consist of 200-250 words, Bookman Old Style, 11 pts., 1.15 line spacing and justified text, following the structured format below:
 - a. Introduction (20% of the space) explain the research problem and objectives; discuss the current state of research in the field, expose a gap, and explain why the present study is timely and necessary
 - b. **Methods** (25% of the space) explain how was the research conducted; discuss the research design/approach, sampling, data collection and analysis tools, etc.








- c. Results (30% of the space) explain what was found out; report important findings; label/number all tables and figures following the APA 7th edition format
- d. Discussion (25% of the space) explain the implications and value of the research; it can be done by: 1) summarizing key findings; 2) connecting such findings to other research or literature; 3) discussing flaws/limitations of the study as input for further studies; 4) stating the implications of findings for policy formulation or improving educational practice
- e. Keywords list down important words/concepts; text must be italicized and alphabetized, separated by commas (Please see attached template for reference.)
- 6. There will be two types of presentation as follows:
 - a. Oral Presentation
 - b. Poster Presentation
- 7. Research proponents that passed the initial evaluation/screening of the SDRC Secretariat will be notified to submit their full paper.
- 8. Abstracts that will not follow the prescribed parts/format shall be disqualified.
- 9. The presentation mechanics shall be issued through a separate Memorandum.
