The banner-making contest shall be participated by teams based on the EXECOM portfolio offices. It will be used during the parade on June 23, 2022, at 8:00 in the morning. Banners will be displayed in the Bulwagan ng Karunungan.



#### **Banner Contest Rules**

 The banner should be eco-friendly and promote the 4Rs (Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle), the 124th founding anniversary theme, and the overall DepEd spirit.

The banner size MUST be no larger than 36"x84" - Horizontal/Landscape only!! Banners that are not Horizontal/Landscape are therefore disqualified - that means the banner will not be judged for competition. There is no specific weight required for the banner for as long as it can be carried by 3 to 4 persons during the parade.

 All banners must be two-dimensional (2D). Three-dimensional (3D) banners will not be accepted! Banners with wet glue, wet surfaces, or pieces that may fall off will NOT BE ALLOWED. Banner stand or wheels are ALLOWED but will NOT BE part of the judging.

 Materials are limited to that which can be hung on the wire/string/cord.

Banner winners will be announced towards the end of the program on June 23, 2022, and special prizes will be awarded. Banner winners will be posted on the official DepEd Facebook Page at DepEd Philippines.

Criteria for Judging

50% - Theme Originality (demonstrates unique incorporation of 124th Anniversary theme, ecofriendly materials, promotion of 4Rs, and DepEd spirit)

30% - Artistic Quality 20% - Overall Neatness



#### **GUIDELINES**

- All entries should have a minimum of fifteen (15) members. We encourage the participation of the Directors and Assistant Directors.
- All members of the entries should be bona fide DepEd employees (Permanent and COS).
- A panel of judges shall determine the winners based on the foregoing criteria. Any violation of the foregoing rules may cause a point deduction per violation on the final score. The decision of the panel shall be final and irrevocable.
- The management will determine performance order via drawing of lots during the meeting which will be coordinated by the focal.



#### **MECHANICS**

#### **Performance Rules**

- The duration of the dance should be a minimum of 3 minutes, and a maximum of 5 minutes including intro and extro.
- No vulgarity, obscenity, or explicit content is allowed.
- Political rallies and/or protest dance concepts are also not allowed.



#### **MECHANICS**

#### **Costumes and Props**

- Costumes must be decent.
- All costume malfunctions resulting in team members being exposed are grounds for deductions. Please make sure to have dress rehearsals before the competition/recording to work out any costume problems
- Props that are not considered an integral part of the attire or performance are prohibited (i.e, fireworks, or any explosives).
- Attire may include accessories such as hats, scarves, caps, gloves, jewelry, etc. Removing pieces of clothing during the performance is permitted provided it is not offensive or out of character.
- Body/face oils or paints/other substances applied to the body or clothing that may affect the safety are prohibited.



#### **MECHANICS**

**Music Requirements** 

 There is no maximum or a minimum number of songs/recordings that may be used in the routine and may be edited to enhance choreography and personal performance.

 The competition music must not contain inappropriate, lewd, or offensive language.

 Kindly take note of the music copyright policy since the recorded presentation will be part of the live streaming on the DepEd Philippines Facebook page.

#### **CRITERIA FOR JUDGING**

A. CONTENT. - 30%

 Variety of dance positions, movements, and combinations appropriate to the specific dance.

 The difficulty of dance movements and combinations from one dance position or

alignment to another.

 Uniqueness or originality of dance movements and combinations from one dance position or alignment to another, to include presentation of dance position.

 Continuity of dance movements and combinations to either interpret dance theme and music or demonstrate dance control. This refers to exceptional phrasing, which includes spontaneous adjustments of dance patterns for irregularly phrased musical selections.



#### **CRITERIA FOR JUDGING**

B. EXECUTION. - 30%

 The basic pattern, rhythm, timing, and initial phrasing between partners and selected music. Phrasing may be shifted for momentary variation for correctly phrased musical selections but generally should be maintained throughout the specific dance.

 Proper performance of footwork, hand, head, arm, and body movements through dance variations, including balance and centering through executed movements.

 Alignment, framework, and proper presentation of dance positions; to include smoothness of follow-through from movement into position; to demonstrate properly initiated lead and follow technique from the position into movement.



#### CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

C. STYLE. - 30%

 Artistic interpretation and choreography projected through dance movement relate to the selected music and the specified dance category.

 Attentiveness, enthusiasm, enjoyment of the dance, and general good partnership as through perceived the appropriate presentation of lead and follow roles.

 Flair and accent of dance movement. generating an atmosphere and instilling a mood appropriate to the specific dance category.

#### D. COSTUME AND OVERALL IMPACT - 10%

- Appropriateness of the costume to the presentation includes color balance.
- Creativity and innovativeness.



#### Shooting Guide for the Regional Presentation Video

 The following procedures are recommended when recording a dance video:

The subject must be positioned in the center of the frame (i.e., the rule of thirds

must be observed);

 A wide shot (i.e., shows the subject within the surrounding environment) or full shot (i.e., shows the subject's entire body) from a still camera is recommended. Likewise. a tracking shot (i.e., the camera moves alongside, towards, or away from the subject) may also be recorded to make the video more dynamic;

 Check the framing of the subject and give enough headroom between the top of the subject's head and the top of the screen

Set the audio recording to Stereo;



### Shooting Guide for the Regional Presentation Video

 The following procedures are recommended when recording a dance video:

 Choose a good location with ample lighting and space for movement (e.g., classroom, gymnasium, hall, open field). Remove any unnecessary or distracting items in the background.

 Illuminate the subject by using a ring light or any source of light (e.g., by facing the window). Avoid positioning the subject

against the light source.

 Rehearse as much as possible, so the subject feels comfortable and prepared when dancing in front of the camera.

 Adherence to minimum health and safety protocols must be observed and shown in the video. Ensure standard health protocols.



### Shooting Guide for the Regional Presentation Video

- The recommended minimum specifications for videos are as follows:
  - File format: MP4 (with 1080p or 720p resolution)
  - Dimensions: 1920px x 1080px (16:9)
  - Orientation: Landscape
  - Frame rate: 30fps
  - Music: Royalty-free or non-copyrighted
