

CASCADING OF PHILHEALTH LEARNER'S MATERIALS (PLM) THROUGH SCHOOL-BASED LEARNING ACTION CELL (LAC) SESSIONS

- 1. In reference to DepEd Memorandum No. 349, s. 2025 titled "PhilHealth Learner's Material (PLM) Training of Trainers," this Office reiterates its commitment in strengthening health literacy among learners through the effective integration of the PhilHealth Learner's Materials (PLM) in the Grade 8 MAPEH subject.
- 2. To ensure the widespread and effective dissemination of the knowledge and skills gained from the recent training, the school heads shall conduct school-based Learning Action Cell (LAC) sessions focusing on PLM, monitor its proper cascading, and facilitate the classroom observation process in their respective schools.
- 3. Furthermore, a classroom observation will be conducted from January to February 2026 to assess the effectiveness of PLM utilization in instruction.
- 4. The narrative accomplishment report, encompassing findings from LAC sessions and classroom observations, must be submitted on March 15, 2026. Submissions should be made exclusively through the provided Google Drive link: https://tinyurl.com/DistrictPhilHealthNAR.

Dear Mr. Bautista:

PhilHealth has started the integration of the PhilHealth Learners Material (PLM) through the inclusion of the topic on PhilHealth in the Grade 10 MAPEH Curriculum under Consumer Health in 2018.

In light of the revisions to the PLM to include the provisions of the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act of 2019 and the changes in the DepEd 2016 curriculum repositioning the topic " Health Information, Products, Services and Providers" to be shifted to Grade 8, we have recently finished the training on the PLM for School Heads, EPS MAPEH and MAPEH Coordinators.

To ensure proper implementation of the PLM by SY 2025-2026, a comprehensive orientation on UHC and PhilHealth policies and benefits for Grade 8 MAPEH teachers will be conducted during their in service training per congressional district. Likewise, as part of our evaluation on the PLM implementation, we will conduct an observation teaching for one school per congressional district within January to March 2026.

Additionally, with the recent signing of the Memorandum of Understanding between DepEd and PhilHealth, DepEd will adopt mechanisms necessary for PhilHealth registration, transforming schools into health-promoting learning environments and school clinics into efficient providers of primary care. To ensure this, we encourage you to have the DepEd Division of Quezon as PhilHealth Konsulta Package Provider to make primary care services accessible for both learners and their families.
