

- 1. In line with DepEd Order No. 24, s. 2022 or the **Adoption of the Basic Education**Development Plan (BEDP) 2030, regarding the provision of timely and demandresponsive technical support to all schools and community learning centers (CLCs)
  in support to the attainment of DepEd BEDP 2030, the School Governance and
  Operations Division (SGOD), in collaboration with the Curriculum Implementation
  Division (CID), shall provide technical assistance and monitoring of the opening of
  classes to sampled schools in the four congressional districts on August 29 to
  September 1, 2023.
- 2. In the provision of technical assistance, only the school head and select key teachers shall be involved, and classes shall not be disrupted as per DO 09, s. 2005 or Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.
- 3. The Division Field Technical Assistance (DFTA) Teams shall:
  - a. provide in advance the schools concerned with a copy of the FTA Form 1 to be accomplished before and validated during the school visit;
  - b. attend the Planning Meeting via Zoom on August 21, 2023, 1:00 p.m., to

- i. discuss travel arrangements and tools,
- ii. plan team strategies on the actual provision of TA, and
- iii. explain post-TA debriefing and reporting.
- c. provide TA in the form of coaching/mentoring (may use a lecture-material); and
- d. foster rapport building and supportive approach in dealing with the TA recipients/beneficiaries.
- 4. The **Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs)** are encouraged to assist the DFTA Teams for the success of this endeavor.
- 5. To ensure safety of all involved, minimum health and safety protocols shall be enforced during the conduct of the activity.
- 6. Please see Enclosure for the DFTA team assignment and itinerary.
- 7. Be advised that the details on the **schedule of school visit** shall be communicated directly by the DFTA Teams to the concerned districts/schools.
- 8. Districts/schools not included in the itinerary of the DTFA Teams shall be monitored and provided with appropriate TA by their respective PSDSs, as necessary.
- 9. Travel and other incidental expenses of the DFTA personnel shall be charged against the Division Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), subject to usual accounting rules and regulations.
