

With the desire to continuously improve the quality of instruction in the Senior High School, the Schools Division of Quezon, through its CID Project SHINE (Strengthening Holistic Instructions to Nurture Teaching Empowerment), will hold an activity dubbed as ONLINE REVIEW OF SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM PROGRAM FOR POSSIBLE ADJUSTMENT AND DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. 19, S. 2016 on August 16 17, 2022 at 8:00 am to 5:00 pm via Zoom Application.

- 6. Determine the provisions of DO No. 19, s. 2016 that need full implementation; and
- 7. Appreciate the value of revisiting DO No. 19, s. 2022.
