REITERATION ON THE USE OF ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODE (ADM) MODULES DURING CLASS SUSPENSION DUE TO TYPHOONS, CALAMITIES, AND OTHER EMERGENCIES

- In light of the recurring suspension of classes due to typhoons, natural calamities, and other unforeseen events that make face-to-face classes not possible, this Office reiterates the use of ADM modules to ensure learning continues through modular or online delivery.
- All schools are hereby reminded of the existing DepEd policies that support learning continuity during emergencies, particularly the use of modular learning through printed ADM materials.
- Teachers must ensure that learners receive the necessary modules in advance, especially during times of expected disruptions. Learners should complete the modules during class suspensions, with teachers providing support and feedback once classes resume or through remote means if needed.
- The use of LR SPARK (Quezon Learning Resource Portal) in our Division website, which provides localized materials and learning resource links, is also encouraged.
