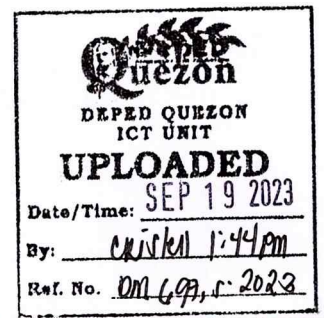

SUBJECT : 2023 INTERNATIONAL COASTAL CLEAN-UP

1. **Presidential Proclamation No. 470 Series of 2003**, declared the **Third (3rd) Saturday of September of each year** as the "International Coastal Clean-Up Day". This year's International Coastal Clean-Up will be celebrated on the third Saturday of this month - September 16, 2023.
2. International Coastal Cleanup aims to **engage people around the world to remove trash and debris from beaches, waterways and other water bodies**, to identify the sources of the litter, to change behaviors that causes pollution and to raise awareness on the extent of the marine debris problem.
3. Taking into consideration the Environmental Educational and Sustainability program of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, all Scouts and Scout Leaders is encouraged to initiate the conduct of a clean-up drive activity that include cleaning and collecting trashes that pollutes our waterways at homes, schools, communities, public plazas, parks, coastal areas, forest areas, watershed areas, campsites and other suitable areas.
4. Documentary and pictorial report indicating the actual clean-up drive shall be submitted and endorsed by Local Council to the National Office on or before 31 October 2023.
5. Certificate of Recognition will be issued to all Scouts and Scout Leaders who will be participating and taking part on the said activity.
