### DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE ON THE STRUCTURAL INTEGRITY AND STANDARD MAINTENANCE OF BUILDING AND OTHER LEARNING FACILITIES

- 1. In line with the Department of Education Memorandum No. 231, s. 2006, titled "Assessment of the Schoolbuildings' Structural Integrity and Stability (ASSIST) Nationwide," this Office, through the SGOD-DRRM Unit, announces the conduct of the "Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Conference on the Structural Integrity and Standard Maintenance of Building and Other Learning Facilities." on September 15-16, 2025 at M.I Sevilla Resort and Hotel, Brgy. Domoit, Lucena City.
- 2. The expected participants in the said activity are the School Heads or the designated Project Development Officer I (PDO I). As the PDO I is assigned to a cluster of schools, he or she may represent only one school during the conference. To ensure orderliness and to avoid overcrowding, participants will be organized into two batches. The list of districts assigned per batch is indicated in Enclosure Nos. 2 and 3, and participants are strictly advised to join only the batch to which their district is assigned.
  - Batch 1 September 15, 2025 536 participants (see Enclosure No. 2)
  - Batch 2 September 16, 2025 425 participants (see Enclosure No. 3)

- 3. In line with DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 (Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith), teaching personnel are discouraged from representing their School Heads in the said activity.
- 4. Medical staff will be on-site during the activity; however, participants who are on maintenance medication are reminded to bring own prescribed medicines to address their personal medical needs.
- 5. For the convenience of participants from island municipalities and those residing more than 50 kilometers away from the venue, "Day Zero" travel may be availed to allow sufficient preparation. Expenses incurred for transportation, meals, and accommodation during Day Zero and during the implementation of the activity shall be chargeable against the School MOOE or other available local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Meals of the participants during the conduct of the activity shall be charged to the Disaster Preparedness and Response Program (DPRP) Continuing Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.
- 7. Widest and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.


