Pursuant to the mandate of the Child Protection Unit (CPU) to lead in the planning, implementing, coordinating, monitoring, and evaluation of programs, projects, and activities related to child protection at all governance levels of the Department<sup>1</sup>.

Further, all schools are directed to submit to their respective SDOs accomplished reports on incidents of bullying and child abuse, cases involving children at risk (CAR) and children in conflict with the law (CICL), copies of their School-Based Child Protection Policy, and Anti-Bullying Policy certifying their adoption and localization of DO 40, s. 2012<sup>3</sup>, and reports on the status of their established child protection committees (CPC).

Cyber Bullying - any bullying done through the use of technology or any electronic means (texting, email, chatting, online games, etc.)
