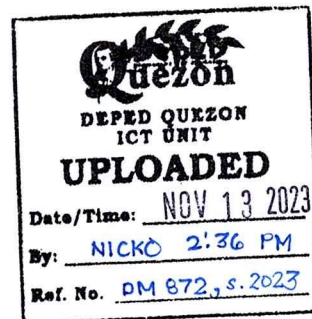

1. As part of the implementation of the Barkada Kontra Droga (BKD) Program in schools reflected in the **Dangerous Drugs Board Regulation No. 5, s. 2007** titled **Institutionalizing the Barkada Kontra Droga (BKD) Program**, this Office, through the School Governance and Operations Division – Learner Formation Section, advises on all members of the BKD organizations in all public secondary schools and the BKD Junior Advocates in selected central elementary schools on the nationwide celebration of the **Drug Abuse Prevention and Control (DAPC) Week 2023**.
2. Relative to this, **DAPC Fest of Talents and Life Skills Training** shall be conducted on **November 18, 2023** at **Pagbilao National High School, Pagbilao, Quezon**.
3. The set of activities aims to:
 - a. demonstrate learners' awareness against the ill effects of harmful substances including tobacco and alcohol through showcase of talents; and
 - b. develop learners' life skills specifically social awareness, assertiveness, leadership, initiative, productivity, collaboration, and interpersonal skills.
4. DAPC 2023 will focus on the theme **People First: Stop Stigma and Discrimination, Strengthen Prevention**.
5. Kindly read the enclosures for schedules and mechanics of the contests.

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6. In compliance with the no disruption of classes policy as stipulated in **DepEd Order No. 09, s. 2005**, interested BKD members shall create their outputs outside class hours or as a take home assignment.
7. Participants and school-based committees involved are advised to strictly adhere to time-on-task policy and community guidelines on safety and health protocols.
8. Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of school-based contests, travel and other preparatory activities of the official school representatives and participants shall be charged against local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

Contest Mechanics

A. General Instructions for All Contests

1. Materials will be provided by the contestant.
2. Jingle-making and logo designing outputs should be originally created by the contestants. No contestant is allowed to copy from the Internet or other resource materials.
3. There will be three winners for each contest in the Division Level. Prizes of the winners will be announced in a separate memorandum.
4. No distinguishing mark or name of school or name of the contestants shall appear in the entry.
5. No foul or inappropriate language or figures shall be used.
6. Contest outputs will be the property of the Division Office.
7. Violation to any of the general and specific contest mechanics shall be ground for disqualification.
8. Judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

B. Substance Use Prevention (SUP) Tagisang Ka-Barkada Quiz Bee

1. The official school contestant must be currently enrolled as a Grade 6 learner in the schools listed in Enclosure 2. A school identification card, parental consent form (Enclosure 6) and BKDJA membership form must be presented as proof during the Division Final Competition. All contestants shall wear white shirt and maong pants and shall be accompanied by their BKDJA teacher-adviser during the quiz show.
2. Each contestant shall bring their own 1/8 illustration boards, chalks, and erasers.
3. Only the capital letter of the contestant's answer shall be written on the board.
4. The time allotment and pointing system for each round shall be as follows:

Round	Time	Points
<i>Easy</i>	10 seconds	2
<i>Average</i>	15 seconds	3
<i>Difficult</i>	20 seconds	5

5. The quiz master shall read the questions and choices twice. Contestants must write their answers on their boards after the quiz master gives the go signal.
6. After the given time, all contestants must raise their boards for checking of answers and recording of scores.
7. In case of tie, clincher questions shall be answered. First to give the correct answer will be declared the winner.
8. Only contestants themselves can raise their hands for questions, appeals and/or clarifications.
9. The top three (3) scorers will be declared winners.

C. Jingle-Making Contest

1. Jingle making shall be open to a group of junior high school students with a

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- minimum of 5 members and maximum of 10 members, one entry per school only.
2. The jingle must be an original composition in Filipino language and must not have been used as entry in any song competitions.
 3. The content of the jingle must be lively, appealing, creative and must highlight on the theme **Barkadahan Kontra Droga at Masasamang Bisyo**.
 4. Any musical instrument can be used as accompaniment at the composer's discretion.
 5. The jingle must be in mp3 format and must be submitted in a flash drive with no other contents/files.
 6. The duration of the jingle entry must be 3 minutes. Every minute excess shall be equivalent to a point deduction.
 7. The printed copies (A4) of lyrics of the official entry, list of team members including the name of district and school, certificate of originality (Enclosure 5) and the flash drive must be placed and submitted in a brown envelope with proper labels on or before **November 16, 2023**. The entries shall directly submitted to the SGOD office.

Criteria for Judging:

Composition (catchy melody, lively music, rhythm and recall) –	40%
Relevance to the theme (Barkadahan Kontra Droga at Masasamang Bisyo) –	20%
Lyric Content (originality, clarity of message, language and phrasing) -	15%
Creativity (use of structure, instruments and vocals) –	15%
<u>Impact (appeal to the listener) –</u>	<u>10%</u>
Total –	100%

D. Logo Designing Contest

1. Logo designing shall be open to senior high school students, one entry per school.
2. The logo must be an original design/creation in digital format and must not be similar with other existing logos.
3. The logo must highlight on the theme Barkadahan Kontra Droga at Masasamang Bisyo and also Quezonian culture.
4. Any photo designing and editing applications can be used but the final output must be saved in high resolution PNG format.
5. The PNG file of the logo and PDF file of the certificate of originality (Enclosure 5) must be placed and submitted through email at **sdo.quezon.yfd@deped.gov.ph** on or before **November 16, 2023** with the subject **QUEDAPAOOfficialLogoEntry/DistrictName/SchoolName/NameOfContestant**.

Creativity –	25%
Originality -	25%
<u>Visual Impact –</u>	<u>10%</u>
Total –	100%
