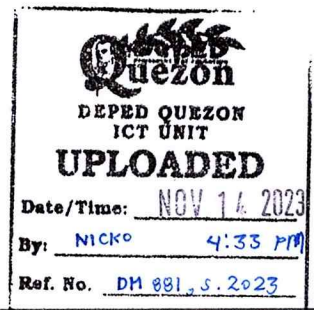

2. **School heads and non-teaching personnel** are the priority in the delegation. Where cases that officers/members are teachers, they should ensure that alternative learning modalities are in place so as not to disrupt instructional time. *and participation is on official time only.*

The 18-Day Campaign to End VAW is an advocacy campaign that is observed annually from November 25 to December 12 as mandated by Presidential Proclamation 1172 s. 2006. It supports the Philippine government's goal of protecting the human rights of women and girls by upholding its commitment to address all forms of gender-based violence as enshrined in the 1987 Constitution. Moreover, by virtue of Republic Act 10398 or the Act declaring November 25 of every year as the National Consciousness Day for the Elimination of VAWC, government agencies are mandated to raise awareness on the problem of violence and the elimination of all forms of violence against women and girls.

Relative thereto, the Province of Quezon being the pioneer in Gender and Development (GAD) programs regularly conducts a **MEN'S DAY CELEBRATION** during the 18 Day Campaign to End VAW. For this year, the Men's Day Celebration will be held on December 1, 2023 at the Quezon Convention Center with an invited audience of approximately Two Thousand Five Hundred (2,500) individuals from almost all of Quezon's municipalities and cities as well as from National Government Agencies (NGAs) and other concerned sectoral groups. Attached is the draft program of the said activity.


In view hereof, we are requesting DEPED's active participation in the said event through the following:

- Attendance of 400 to 500 Deped personnel/members of Machete or other organizations from DEPED;
- Participants in the TikTok Dance contest of male members (maximum of 10 participants);
- Participants in the Ginoong MOVE/Makabagong Andres.

Moreover, as agreed upon in our previous meetings, the DEPED delegates were entrusted with the duty to prepare the guidelines for the TikTok Dance contest and Ginoong MOVE/Makabagong Andres contest.
