

Arts across various learning areas, demonstrating a comprehensive understanding of agricultural concepts and their application in educational settings.

#### **Enabling Objective/s:**

At the end of the training - workshop, the participants will be able to:

- 1. Identify and define key principles of Organic Agriculture Production (OAP), Agri-Crop Production (ACP), and Fishery Arts through a pre-course reading assignment.
- 2. Demonstrate knowledge by successfully completing a quiz assessing understanding of key concepts in Organic Agriculture Production, Agri-Crop Production, and Fishery Arts.
- 3. Collaborate with peers to brainstorm and document at least three examples of how agricultural concepts can be integrated into different learning areas.
- 4. Present and discuss the identified integration opportunities with the group, seeking feedback and refining ideas for practical implementation.
- 5. Analyze existing lesson plans to identify opportunities for integrating agricultural concepts effectively.
- 6. Make a draft daily lesson plan incorporating at least two agricultural concepts into the chosen subject matter; and
- 7. Participate in a peer review session to receive constructive feedback and refine the lesson plan for clarity and effectiveness.
- 3. The participants to the above mentioned activity are School Heads and teachers of ten RFS school applicants of DepEd Quezon who are expected to have an online registration at <a href="https://tinyurl.com/HGrb-twIAC">https://tinyurl.com/HGrb-twIAC</a> not later than November 24, 2023. - 4. All participants are expected to bring their laptop and extension cord for the workshop.

- 6. Attached herewith is the training Matrix for the said event.







