- a. provide a learner-centered platform to engage and mobilize learners with various backgrounds who will participate in different carefully designed interactive and participatory activities that promote upskilling, high sense of social responsibility, acceptance, and respect of differences;
- serve as an opportunity to Filipino learners to connect with others, share their common goals and sentiments, take part in gleeful engagements, and showcase the causes they volunteer for and capabilities from different fields of expertise;
- c. celebrate the role of young people in the thrust for nation-building;
- d. amplify the message that the valuable contribution and collective manifestation of learners around the country matter and are needed across all disciplines of education to achieve positive change; and
- e. appreciate young people's "puso, galing, at talino" in bridging the gaps and creating opportunities for lifelong and holistic learning and development.

Pursuant to the *Republic Act 11369*, otherwise known as the "*National Students' Day Act*", it mandates the National Youth Commission (NYC), Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Department of Education (DepEd) to conduct an annual program of activities that will promote the love of country and social responsibility among the youth and to support the observance of International Students' Day.

This year's national celebration shall be hosted by DepEd – Davao Region, specifically the Schools Division Office of Davao del Sur, in partnership with the Local Government of Davao del Sur.

In this regard, the OUOPS hereby requests all schools to celebrate the National Students' Day by organizing relevant activities through the Supreme Learner Government.
