- 1. 

#### DIGITAL POSTER MAKING CONTEST 2023 FOR NATIONAL CHILDREN MONTH

1. Entries should be able to interpret the theme "HEALTHY, NOURISHED, SHELTERED:

#### ENSURING THE RIGHT TO LIFE FOR ALL"

- 2. Each contestant shall submit only (1) digital poster entry. To avoid copyright infringement, it should be the contestant's original work. Moreover:
  - The use of trademark logos is prohibited, and
  - The use of downloadable materials from the internet and other materials made by other person is also prohibited.
- 3. The contestant may use any software and gadget of choice.
- 4. The digital poster should be in portrait orientation, in digital format, and must have the following requirements:
  - Document Size: 11x 16 inches
  - Resolution: atleast 100 ppi/pixel oer inch
  - File Format: jpeg
  - Must not contain any copyrighted materials including artworks.
  - Must not have been submitted or awarded in any other digital poster making contest or have been published in print or online.
- 5. All entries will be considered property of the Schools Division of Quezon and may be used by the section for publication or any other legal purposes.
- 6. Consistent with the provisions of the Data Privacy Act and with DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012., student contestants must secure parents' consent, as some of the personal information of the winners will be published and posted on social media.
- 7. The Schools Division of Quezon shall not be liable for any infringement of any intellectual property rights arising from the use of the entries. In case there are third-party claims of such infringement of any intellectual property rights, contestants hold DepEd free and harmless against such claims.
- 8. Non-compliance with any of the stated contest rules and mechanics is a ground for disqualification.
- 9. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.
