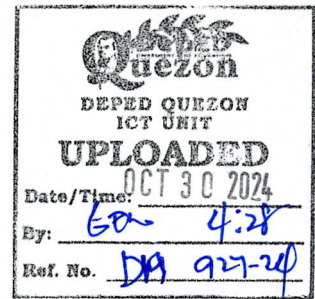

1. Under RA 11510, the Alternative Learning System (ALS) provides accessible, adaptable non-formal education for marginalized out-of-school youth and adults. Sections 3 and 4 emphasize improving learning outcomes and lifelong skills through alternative education paths, while Sections 5.6 and 5.7 focus on program flexibility to meet diverse learner needs. ALS integrates real-world assessments to equip learners with practical skills for societal and workforce roles. In line with this, DepEd Quezon, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, will hold the **PROJECT CARE ENHANCEMENT TRAINING-WORKSHOP FOR CLUSTER 6 ALS IMPLEMENTERS: COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT THROUGH REAL-WORLD EXPERIENCES** on November 6-7, 2024, at Mulanay Central School, Mulanay District 2, Mulanay, Quezon.

2. This activity aims to:
 - a. equip ALS Implementers with the skills and knowledge necessary to design, implement, and evaluate comprehensive assessments that reflect real-world experiences;

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- b. acquire practical understanding of how to align assessment practices with the broader goals of the ALS program, fostering lifelong learning and employability skills among learners;
 - c. develop and create practical assessment tools and task that reflect real-life scenarios relevant to the learning outcomes of ALS learners, ensuring these tools cater to the diverse needs of learners;
 - d. evaluate and adjust assessment tools to ensure they are inclusive, fair, and aligned with learning goals;
 - e. work collaboratively with fellow ALS implementers to discuss and exchange best practices for addressing challenges in conducting comprehensive assessment.
3. Participants to this activity are Education Program Specialists for ALS, ALS Teachers, DepED-engaged and LGU-engaged Community ALS Implementors (CAIs). Please see enclosure for the list of participants. Participants are advised to bring laptop for the workshop and other related activities.
