- 1. In reference to the Regional Memorandum No. 687, s. 2025, this Division reiterates the aforementioned subject.
- 2. This initiative aims to proactively address potential threats and create a safe learning environment. All personnel and learners are reminded to refrain from acts of violence and possession of illegal items such as firearms, bladed weapons, drugs, pornographic materials, poison, cigarettes, and other prohibited paraphernalia.
- 3. All schools are directed to coordinate with their respective local offices for guidance on the procurement, installation, and proper usage of handheld metal detectors.
- 4. The proposed technical specifications are attached as Annex A. Schools may determine or provide their own specifications based on their identified needs and priorities, subject to existing rules and regulations. Funding for this initiative shall be charged against school MOOE/local DRRM fund/any available fund, subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations of the Department.

## REITERATION ON ENSURING THE SAFETY OF LEARNERS IN SCHOOLS THROUGH ACQUISITION OF HANDHELD METAL DETECTOR

#### To: Schools Division Superintendents

- In reference to DepEd Memorandum OSEC-2025-003<sup>1</sup>, this Office, through the Education Support Services Division, reiterates the aforementioned subject.
- 2. This initiative aims to enhance the protection of learners, teachers, and staff by proactively addressing potential threats and ensuring a safe learning environment as well as to emphasize the duties and responsibilities of both personnel and learners to refrain from committing acts of violence and possessing illegal articles such as gun/firearm, bladed weapons, drugs, pornographic materials, poison, cigarettes, and other similar paraphernalia.
- Relative to this, all schools are expected to coordinate with their respective local offices for guidance on procurement, installation, and proper usage of the equipment more specifically the handheld metal detectors.
- 4. The proposed technical specifications is attached as **Annex A.** Moreover, all Schools Division Offices/Schools are given the opportunity to determine or provide their own technical specifications in accordance with their identified needs and priorities subject to the existing rules and regulations and shall be charged against school MOOE/local DRRM fund/any available fund, subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations of the Department.


