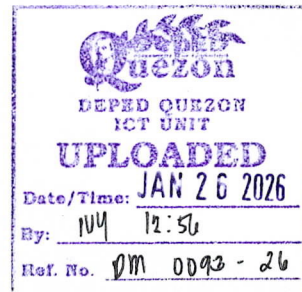

**CONDUCT OF THE STATE OF THE LEARNER GOVERNMENT ADDRESS (SOLGA)
FOR THE END OF SCHOOL YEAR 2025-2026**

1. In compliance to **OUOPS Memorandum No. 2023-03** titled **Interim Guidelines of the Learner Government Program (LGP)**, this Office, through the School Governance and Operations Division – Learner Formation Section (SGOD-LFS), informs all presidents of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) on the conduct of the State of the Learner Government Address (SOLGA) for the end of School Year 2025-2026.
2. As stated in Article X, Section 1.11 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government and Supreme Secondary Learner Government, the SELG/SSLG president shall conduct a State of the Learner Government Address (SOLGA) during the first and last quarter of the school year. All SELG/SSLG presidents shall conduct their SOLGA during the flag raising ceremony or general assembly of learners in their respective schools on a chosen date from **February 2, 2026 to February 27, 2026**. The SOLGA must highlight significant accomplishments on the following:
 - a. Promotion of DepEd's Core Values in the school
 - b. Conducted Programs, Projects, and Activities as reflected in the action plan
 - c. Learner support activities conducted to assist learner-related outcomes
 - d. Resolutions/policy recommendations passed through the SELG/SSLG
 - e. Other accomplishments of the SELG/SSLG

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3. A one-page newsletter report with photo documentation shall be prepared and submitted by each elementary and secondary school to the District School Head In-Charge of Learner Formation in PDF file on or before **March 2, 2026**.
4. The District School Head In-Charge shall merge all submitted reports in one PDF file and upload the merged reports in the link **<https://tinyurl.com/SOLGAEnd2526>** with the filename **NameOfDistrict_SOLGA** on or before **March 6, 2026**.
5. Conduct of all activities related to the Learner Government Program (LGP) shall follow the provisions in **DepEd Order No. 09, s. 2005 – Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith; DepEd Order No. 03, s. 2023 – An Order Allowing the Conduct of In-person Activities in Schools;** and community guidelines on safety and health protocols.
6. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance to this Memorandum are earnestly desired.
