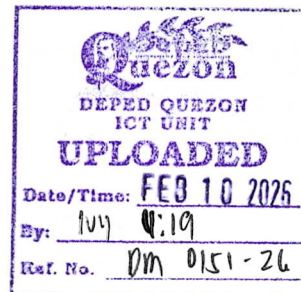

**MALACAÑAN PALACE PROTOCOL**

1. *Prior to entry to the Palace, all guests must register in the Visitor's Management System (VMS). Please see instructions below:*

- b. Wait for the prompt / notification "Awesome."
- c. Wait for the approval email containing the QR Code.

2. *Malacañan Palace Entry Process:*

- a. DepEd ExeCom and staff shall enter the Malacañan Palace through Gate 6.
- b. Upon entry, **guests shall present their QR code** sent via email.
- c. The PSC (formerly PSG) personnel shall then request a **valid ID** from guests and shall hand out a visitor's ID in return.
- d. Thereafter, guests shall be ushered to the venue.
- e. Deadline of registration: **no later than 10 February 2026**, on or before **12:00 PM**.

**Note: NO NAME ON THE GUESTS LIST, NO QR CODE, NO ENTRY**

3. Call time for all DepEd participants is **strictly at 7:00 AM**.
4. Parking area for visitors will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Parking slots will be available at Gates 4, 5, and 6.
5. Malacañan implements a **no-cellphone policy** for all Presidential events.
