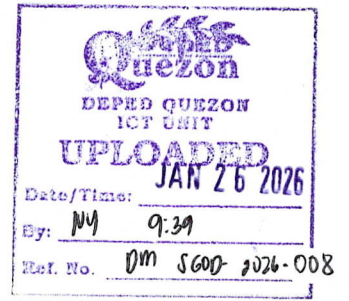



SUBJECT : 2026 STRCO Regional Scout Youth Forum

1. Please be informed that the BSP – Southern Tagalog Region will conduct the 2026 Regional Scout Youth Forum (RSYF) to be hosted by BSP – Lipa City Council on **February 5-7, 2026** at the **Lipa City Science Integrated National High School**.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. Help young Scouts acquire experiences, opportunities, and skills necessary to express their views and opinions constructively, particularly on matters affecting them in the implementation of Scouting programs;
 - b. Enable them to effectively communicate their needs and aspirations on current issues and discover ways to get involved in community service and nation-building; and
 - c. Provide young people with a better understanding of diversity and differences among individuals in order to promote respect, cooperation, and leadership.
3. Qualified Senior Scout participants must:
 - a. Be a currently REGISTERED member of the BSP;
 - b. Be 14 to 18 years old;
 - c. Be a holder of at least the Outdoorsman Rank; and
 - d. Have been elected during the conduct of their 2025 Council Scout Youth Forum (CSYF).
4. Each participating Council may send a maximum of four (4) official delegates and two (2) observers, accompanied by one (1) REGISTERED adult leader.
5. **An Activity Fee of Php. 2,000.00** will be charge each participant to cover Administrative and Logistical expenses and food for the duration of the activity. Likewise, adult leaders in excess of the agreed number will also be charge of Activity Fee. Payment can be deposited in advance at this account below. Just send us a photo of your deposit slip for verification purposes or bring it on site.

6. The Opening Program will commence at 2:00 PM on February 05, 2026.
7. The list of official Delegates and Observers must be submitted to the Regional Office or BSP – Lipa City Council on or before January 30, 2026 (Friday). The Organizing Committee shall prepare a Google Form for participant registration, which will be disseminated through the Regional Office.
8. The RSYF Organizing Committee reminds each delegation to bring the following:
 - a. Post-Forum Report (CSYF); and
 - b. CSYF Certificate of Recognition/Participation (as basis for participation in the RSYF).
9. Participants are advised to bring the following personal items:
 - a. Laptop (preferably one per participant);
 - b. Pocket Wi-Fi;
 - c. Extension cords;
 - d. Beddings (banig, sleeping bag, blanket, and the like);
 - e. Type A uniform (with carabao slide and Senior Scout necker);
 - f. Sufficient civilian clothes for daily activities and sleeping wear;
 - g. One (1) set of casual attire for socials;
 - h. Toiletries;
 - i. Personal medicines; and
 - j. Extra money for emergency expenses.
10. Expenses incurred in connection with this activity may be charged against local funds/MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
